Gophers Survive

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) — Unbeaten Minnesota survived wave on wave of Illinois assaults and rallied behind the three-touchdown salvo of Sandy Stephens for a 21-10 homecoming victory Saturday.

Mauled and bewildered for three periods, the Gophers stormed for two touchdowns in the fourth period for their fourth straight victory and second in the Big Ten.

Buckeyes Dumped

LAFAYETTE, Ind. (AP) — Purdue's productive Bernie Allen kicked a 32-yard field goal and three extra points, passed brilliantly and ran the clutch yardage Saturday in a 24-21 upset of previously unbeaten Ohio State, the nation's No. 3 ranking team.

Willie Jones, senior Purdue fullback, scored two touchdowns on short plunges, then got the third quarter clincher on a 26-yard sprint. He had never before made a collegiate touchdown. Ohio State had given up only one touchdown altogether in three previous games but was smacked with two Purdue TD's before it could score.

MSU Whips Irish

SOUTH BEND, Ind. (AP) —

Senior quarterback Tom Wilson passed for two touchdowns and like Grimley, who calls defensive signals, scored on a 35-yard runback of an interception as Michigan State Saturday handed Notre Dame its third straight football defeat, 21-0.

The victory, before a sellout crowd of 39,133, was the fifth in a row over the Irish for the Duffy Daugherty-coached Spartans.

Cadets Upset

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) — Nebraska's Pat Fischer turned the tide with a bull's-eye pass to Bennie Dillard for a 57-yard third quarter touchdown Saturday and Nebraska won a football victory over Army 14 to 9.

It had been uphill for Nebraska against the aerial minded Cadets all the way to this turning point.

Army grabbed a 3-0 lead in the first quarter on Tom Blanda's 27-yard field goal, and led, 9-7, going into the third period.

K. State Shattered

MANHATTAN, Kan. (AP) — Missouri's power-running backs shattered hopelessly outmanned Kansas State 43-0 Saturday. It was the second Big Eight conference football victory and fifth straight of the season for the Tigers, ranked sixth nationally.

It took the Tigers 11½ minutes, moving 78 yards, to collect their first touchdown. After that, the Tigers moved at will, hampered only occasionally by penalties or a momentarily determined K-State defensive effort.

Seven players got into the scoring act for the winners. The first TD was the result of a 45-yard pass from Doug Maxwell to end Larry Nelson. Halfback Larry Peters scooped up a fumble and rambled 50 yards for the second.

Brother Larry went five yards for the third, Chuck Cossey ran seven yards for the fourth, and fullback Bob Mobley boomed two yards for the last one. Mobley and Dennis Berry each ran a conversion.

Halfback Bucky Wilson got the losers on the board when he peeled off a 50-yard TD run in the third quarter. Bill Artery plunged over for the conversion.

Statistics show that the clubs broke about even in yardage games. Merrill collected 232 while Lakeview got 255.

At the close of their night's work the Honkers had racked up a 3-1 league record.

Cal Casabier notched two conversions off kicks, one off a pass and one with a run. Lugo came through with a successful conversion run also.

Brown was the big gainer for the Hornets. He totaled 83 yards in five carries while Blofsky was selected 61 in nine trips while Ragland was next with 44 five.

The Hornets, outwitted by the losers, got the best use out of their newly-installed multiple offense and received the best blocking and tackling effort of the year, said Weber.

Crater Club Deals Yreka 26-19 Defeat

CENTRAL POINT (Special) — A Yreka offense that sputtered throughout the first half finally got in gear in the second period, but was too late to keep the Crater Cougars from scoring a 26-19 non-league win here Friday night.

Down 14-0 at the half, the Min-

ers, who have won two and lost three so far this season, bounced back to move with one point 20-19 with two minutes left to play.

They threatened to overtake the Cougars with a last-gasp sustained drive but the threat faded when CP's Bob Twedell intercepted a pass and galloped 50 yards for the Comet clincher.

"This is by far the best ball club we have faced," said Yreka coach Tommy Bice. "When they hit, they hit hard." Yreka tests Chiloquin on the Miner grid next Friday night. The Cougars are slated to face Klamath Union in Klamath Falls on October 28.

Loyal Higanbotham hauled in a 15-yard pass from quarterback Mike Glines for the first Crater score. Jack Champ collected the next two TDs with a two-yard plunge and a one-yard dive. Twedell wrapped up the Comet effort.

Yreka quarterback Johnny Ellis climaxed his own 45-yard kick-off return with a five-yard burst for the last Miner score. Kell Green broke the ice for the losers when he intercepted a third quarter pass and sped 51 yards to paydirt. Halfback Butch McCarthy chewed up nine yards for the second Yreka score. McCarthy also ran the lone Miner conversion.

Ken Ryerson booted one for the winners and Twedell snagged a pass for the other point-after.

The struggle was relatively close in the ground-gaining department but Yreka was charged 100 yards in penalties while Central Point drew only one five-yard red flag.
