to as "Tyrex." They are entirely adequate for practically every type of driving.

Nylon tires, though more expensive, provide an extra margin of safety on a fast trip. They heat up less under fast-driving conditions in warm weather and are stronger. A disadvantage is "flat-spotting" from the weight of a car parked overnight, but this will disappear after the first few miles of driving. There also is the "premium" tire made of nylon, intended for those who want the softest possible ride and practically complete freedom from puncture.



Tune-up

Tune-ups are vital, but don't let an overzealous service attendant do more than he should. Here are the items to be checked, along with their normal service life:

Spark plugs should be cleaned every 10,000 miles, replaced at 20,000. Buy standard brands only.

Points should last 20,000 miles. The fact that metal transfer is evident does not always mean they are worn out.

The condenser and coil should last the life of the car, as should the fuel pump.

The cap and rotor of the distributor will last indefinitely if kept clean, as will the wiring.

The carburetor can profit from minor attention every 20,000 miles, principally cleaning. Then it should outlive the car.

Antifreeze



In modern cars it is difficult to obtain adequate performance from the heater unless you install a glycol-type antifreeze and make sure that the 180-degree thermostat is operating properly. Glycol antifreezes are called permanent, but this is a misnomer as the rust inhibitors in them will not last more than one season. Rust will form in the radiator and engine block if the solution is not renewed each fall.

"Super" antifreezes recently appeared on the market. They retain their effectiveness for longer periods. One type is sold with a special "de-ionized" water that should prove useful in such areas as the Southwest where tap water contains damaging chlorides. Another type changes color to warn you when it is wearing out; normally it will give two years of all-season service.

Here are some capsule tips on your cooling system:

Pure tap water is corrosive; use an inhibitor with it... Tip from the desert—turning on the heater will help keep a car from boiling... Ammeter on discharge, temperature high, mean a broken fan belt; stop immediately... A quart of glycol in the summer acts as a water-pump lubricant.

Appearance Conditioning



Cars may be washed safely with cold water containing a mild solution of any household detergent safe for nylons. Soap, no matter how pure, is not recommended because it leaves a film. Road oils and tar can be removed with kerosene, provided the area is immediately flushed with water. Any household window cleaner is suitable for car windows, although rear windows (and tops) of convertibles should be cleaned only with castile soap.

Auto manufacturers have various attitudes toward polishing the new "super" lacquer and enamel finishes. Since you have no way of knowing whether your car is finished in lacquer or enamel, it is best to use polishes or waxes labeled "suitable for acrylic lacquer finishes." Anodized aluminum trim can be damaged by nearly every type of cleaner except water and wax.

Ordinary dirt on the upholstery is removed by any reputable brand of household furniture cleaner, whether of the shampoo type or dry, but remember to cover the entire area of the cushion at a time. Stains from oil-base materials such as lipstick or tar can be removed by carbon tetrachloride. Food and candy stains can be removed by a teaspoon of household detergent in a quart of warm water. Do not use soap. Wipe fabric with a lifting motion, working away from the center of the spot.
