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Big Welcome Set For Ike

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—President Eisenhower will receive an all-out welcome when he arrives in San Francisco next Thursday on his last visit here as President.

Mayor George Christopher said the city's financial district would be turned into a "ticker tape parade in a great civic welcome... and nonpartisan salute to the President." He urged San Franciscans to "do their best for him."

The President is scheduled to arrive at San Francisco International Airport from Denver at 10:30 a.m. PST. He will be transferred at once to a helicopter to be taken to Treasure Island.

The President's helicopter will land at approximately 11:45 a.m. near the base golf driving range where he will be greeted by military officials and civic leaders.

No speeches are scheduled and the party will leave after a 21-gun salute.

Eisenhower will join a motorcade that will take him through downtown San Francisco to his headquarters at the St. Francis Hotel.

Thursday night the President will speak before the Commonwealth Club at the Sheraton-Palace Hotel in his only scheduled address during the visit.

He will leave San Francisco International Airport the following day for San Diego.
