The Mississippi Rebels, opponents know, are a tough defensive outfit. And statistics backed them up today as records of the NCAA Service Bureau disclosed that Ole Miss finally has dislodged Syracuse as the country's leader in rushing defense.

The Rebels' consistency is unmatched in recent major college football records, with Mississippi among the top 10 in one of the four principal defense categories every week since the start of the 1956 season.

Syracuse, leader in rushing defense for more than a year, now holds only one first—a bare decision in total defense over Wyoming.
