Seven Killed In Jet Crash

LANGLEY AIR FORCE BASE, Va. (AP)—A jet tanker, on a night training mission, crashed on a marshy shore near here Wednesday night, carrying seven crewmen to their deaths.

Witnesses said the six-engine KB50-J tanker caught fire almost immediately after takeoff from Langley and was enveloped in a sheet of white flame when it came down with a roar that shook houses miles away.

The seven bodies were removed at the crash scene on the edge of Plumtree Island.

The giant tanker was attached to the 427th Air Refueling Squadron, 4505th Air Refueling Wing, of the Tactical Air Command.

Identities of those who died were withheld by the Air Force pending notification of next-of-kin.
