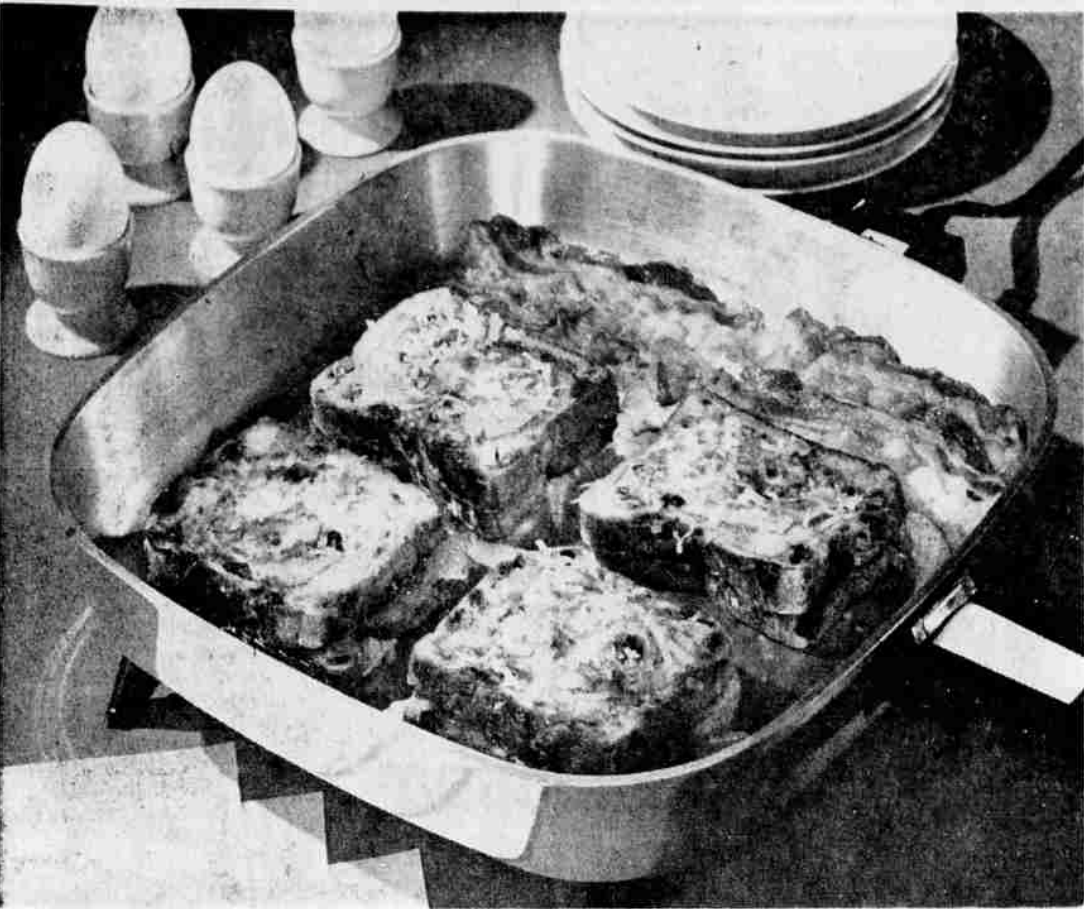




A BRIGHT EYE-OPENER IDEA for breakfast comes to you in these hot jam sandwiches, made with store bought bread, rich in the flavor of the little fruit with the taste surprise. You can make this coffee cake treat almost instantly even when you've overslept. A scrumptious coating of butter and flaked coconut browns to fragrant golden goodness in a skillet or sandwich grill. Serve with bacon and eggs, sizzling hot. When it's sandwich time for the girls, make sandwiches same way but cut into dainty

fingers after they are browned. Here's how: 1/4 cup butter or margarine, 1/4 cup flaked coconut, 1/2 cup apricot jam, 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon, eight slices of raisin bread. Mix coconut with creamed butter. Blend apricot jam with cinnamon. Make four sandwiches from raisin bread and jam. Spread both sides of sandwiches with apricot-coconut mixture. Sauté in hot skillet on both sides until golden brown. Makes four servings. Serve at once.

Three Minute Stove Cleaner

Harried housewives who put off that unwelcome chore of cleaning a greasy oven or who nearly weep when they boil over a kettle of jell will welcome a new "three minute" oven cleanser now on grocer's shelves.

Baked Chicken With Cashew-Bread

- 1 package frozen chicken breasts
- 1 package frozen chicken drumsticks and thighs
- 1 1/2 quarts toasted 1/2-inch bread cubes
- 3/4 cup chopped salted cashew nuts
- 3/4 cup chopped celery
- 1/2 teaspoon poultry seasoning
- 2 1/2 cups water
- 1/2 cup melted butter or margarine
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

three tablespoons butter. Place stuffing in an oblong (2-quart) baking dish. Sprinkle salt and pepper over thawed chicken. Place chicken parts on top of stuffing. Brush chicken with half of remaining butter. Bake in a slow oven (325 degrees F.) for 1 1/2 hours. Baste occasionally with remainder of butter while chicken bakes.
