Airplane Has Mishap On Landing, But All Passengers Safe

ANCHORAGE, Alaska (UPI)—A Northwest Orient Airlines DC7C struck and killed a cow moose and her calf during a landing here Friday but all 26 passengers and seven crew members escaped injury.

The pilot, Capt. Harold Barnes, Seattle, said the airliner had already slowed to landing speed before he saw the animals on the runway.

"I just had to hit them and drag them down the runway," Barnes said.

Passengers aboard the plane, bound for Tokyo, said they felt just a "slight bump" when the plane struck the animals. The landing gear of the plane and several plates on the bottom of the aircraft were damaged.

Driver Education Group Asks Revise Of Statutes

PORTLAND—The Driver Education Study Committee of the Oregon Highway Lifesavers—a statewide citizen organization to enlist public support in reducing highway accidents—has forwarded the following recommendations to the Oregon Legislative Interim Committee on Education:

Cops Suspended

CORVALLIS (AP) — City Manager John Porter announced Friday the indefinite suspension of two Corvallis policemen who admitted violating state game laws.

Porter said Alvin Ebert, 45, and Frank Schamp, 24, would be suspended Tuesday. They earlier pleaded guilty in district court to charges of possessing untagged venison.

1. A change in the present Oregon law to allow Saturday instruction on a permissive basis in the schools.

2. An increase of state reimbursement from the present \$20 per student, to \$30 per student, as an incentive for furthering driver education in the school districts.

3. That the qualifications of driver education teachers be established and administered by the State Department of Education.

The Driver Education Study Committee, composed of 15 educators, laymen and driver educators, in addition to two consultants, held three meetings during the past summer months. The purpose of the committee was to study the present status of driver education in Oregon, and to make recommendations for improvement to the Oregon Legislature.
