Police Probe 4 Accidents

Four traffic accidents were investigated by city police over the weekend. Citations were issued in three of the accidents.

Robert Ray Eacret, 21, 3055 Lodi Street, was cited for reckless driving after his car ran off the road, hit a telephone pole and skidded 129 feet on East Main near Home Street early Saturday morning. The car also destroyed two automatic washing machines worth \$95 which were in front of 345 East Main Street.

Eacret was also charged with furnishing liquor to a minor when police discovered beer in the car and discovered that a minor passenger in the vehicle had been drinking. Eacret was jailed in lieu of \$200 bail.

Bengiman Henry Derby, 720 Wocus Street, was cited for following too closely after an accident at South Sixth Street and Shasta Way Saturday morning. His car collided with one driven by Donald Floyd Tremblay, 1943 Summers Lane.

Keith Albert Harris, 25, 713 North Ninth Street, was cited for failure to yield right of way after his car collided with one driven by Billy Howard McCollough, 24, 1324 Gary Street, at the corner of South Sixth and East Main streets. Officers said Harris made a sudden turn in front of McCollough.

Cars driven by Gary Dean Kaiser, OTI, and Benson Farren Pernigotti, 805 Plum Street, collided when both vehicles attempted a right turn onto South Ninth Street from Main Street.

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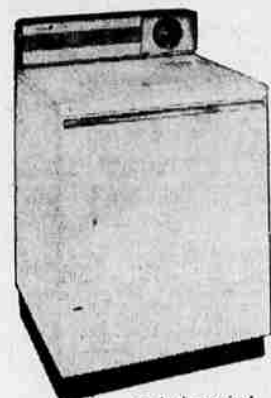
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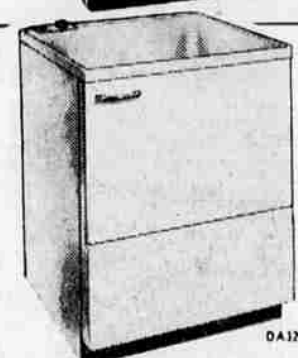


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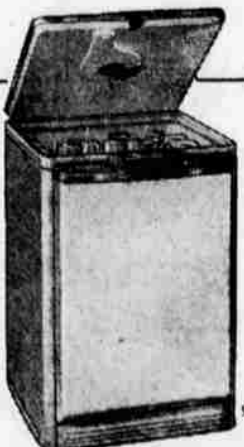
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
