Democrats Outnumber Republicans

SALEM (AP)—Democrats lead Republicans in registration for the November General Election by 75,134 in Oregon, the greatest margin in history.

It is a gain of nearly 20,000 for Democrats over Republicans since the May primary and is nearly double the margin the Democrats held for the 1956 General Election.

Totals compiled today as the last of the counties reported their registration figures showed 899,949 eligible to vote—a record total—with 480,132 of them Democrats and 404,938 Republicans.

The big edge is given to the Democrats by Multnomah County where they lead by 41,988, but of the state's 36 counties 28 have Democratic majorities.
