Clams Flushed From Hydrants At Ontario

ONTARIO, Ore. (AP) — A fire hydrant was opened here Tuesday and tiny fresh water clams came pouring out by the hundreds.

It looked almost as though the street had been graveled, said City Supt. Herb Derrick. The clams ranged from the size of a quarter to a 50-cent piece.

The main pipes in the city's low-pressure system—one not used for drinking water—are filled with them, Derrick said. They cling to the sides of the pipes and threaten to clog the system, he said.

But a 600-pound load of powdered chlorine was poured into the mains and Derrick said he hoped this would kill them. Hydrants at the ends of the lines will be opened in a few days to see if they all flush out.

How they got into the mains and what prompted their great multiplication there is uncertain. Derrick said it was supposed they came in from Owyhee Lake, source of the water.

The low pressure system parallels the drinking water system in about half the city. The water is used for lawn and garden irrigation.
