Man Circles The Earth; Seeks Music

WASHINGTON (UPI) — I have been reading a Library of Congress pamphlet about a fellow who travels around the world tape-recording folk music.

Last year, the collector, Paul F. Bowles, received a grant from the Rockefeller Foundation which enabled him to spend several months in Morocco. He brought back some 60 hours of music which he has turned over to the library's archive of folk song.

One of the things Bowles wanted to record was a rare musical instrument, a sort of primitive stereo, known as the "Zamar." It is a double reed in the bass range which has two mouthpieces and two bulls'-horn resonators.

Bowles finally found one at Sagangen on the eastern edge of the Rif country and captured its sound alive. This was not, however, his most unorthodox specimen.

Rifles As Instruments
At Taza, in the southern Rif country, he recorded a melody of Moroccan tunes played by a 12-man orchestra. The sole function of eight of the musicians was to fire rifles at stated intervals.

I found the pamphlet very interesting and it set me to wishing that I could get a Rockefeller grant for a similar trip around the United States. I would like to record the sounds of parents threatening their children.

I fear these sounds are dying out in America under the precepts of modern child psychology. Parents nowadays are cautioned against threatening children lest they bruise their little psyches.

In a way this is a pity, for it is stifling the use of some of the most colorful folk expressions in our land. As a student of folk ways, I deem it a worthy project to preserve some of these expressions before they disappear from our language entirely.

For example, many is the time I've heard my mother shout: "If you don't stop that I'm going to wear you out." I regard "wear you out" as a true gem of a threat because it works like yeast on the miscreant's imagination. I always had visions of being ground to dust by an emery wheel.

Like Poetry
In parts of the South, mothers used to tell their offspring: "If you do that again, I'll slap you from an amazing grace to a floating opportunity." This, I'm sure you'll agree, is a threat that has a poetic as well as a deterrent quality.

Georgia children of a disobedient nature frequently were warned that they would be taken to the Chattahoochee River and ordered not to jump in.

The only ingenious threat I've heard recently was uttered by a father who threatened to "get out of this chair and drop-kick you across the living room."

It had an old-timey ring suitable for the Library of Congress. His child was too young to remember when the drop-kick was used in football, but the point got across anyway.

ENDS PACIFIC TOUR
NORFOLK, Va. (UPI) — The heavy cruiser Canberra returned to its home port here Monday after a seven-month Pacific tour.

American officials confirmed reports from East European Communist sources that Albanian, only member of the Soviet European bloc to side with Red China, was intensifying its anti-Khrushchev propaganda in diplomatic circles in other satellite countries.

Peking charges Khrushchev with having "deviated" from basic Communist doctrine in his efforts to negotiate with the West.
