Board May Take Action On Filing

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon Water Resources Board indicated Monday it still might take action on the Idaho Power Co.'s application for a license to build three dams in the Middle Snake River. The company now is building the dams under permit from the Federal Power Commission. Brownlee Dam is completed, Oxbow is under construction, and Hell's Canyon project isn't started yet.

George H. Corey, chairman of the board's legal committee, said Atty. Gen. Robert Y. Thornton had advised the board that the company's application is still legally before the board. Corey said he plans to make a recommendation at the board's next meeting. La Selle E. Coles, Prineville, was elected as the new chairman of the board, succeeding Robert W. Root, Medford.
