**Harry Hits Ike's Policy**

NEW YORK (UPI) — Former President Harry S. Truman today charged the Eisenhower administration "refused to enforce the Monroe Doctrine" in regard to Cuba and allowed communism to move "5,000 miles closer to our shores."

"We should have just told them they couldn't come in," Truman said of the Communist-tinged regime of Cuban Premier Fidel Castro. "President (Grover) Cleveland did the same thing in Venezuela."

"There should have been a man in the White House who knew where he was going to go and what he was going to do. That is what happened in regard to Korea."

The former president, in the course of his morning walk with newsmen, criticized President Eisenhower and defended his own decision to send American troops to the aid of the Republic of Korea in 1950, after the Communist North Koreans crossed the 38th parallel.

"We did things in Korea," Truman said.

Truman, here to campaign for Democratic presidential nominee Sen. John F. Kennedy, said he would have invoked the Monroe Doctrine to stop Castro. "I would not have let the Communists in," he said.

The former president said this could have been done without force and without violating the nation's commitments to the Organization of American States because "the Monroe Doctrine is specifically protected in the treaty."

He said he agreed with Kennedy that it would be a "good idea" to strengthen anti-Castro forces. He called the bearded Cuban revolutionary "the Khrushchev of the Western Hemisphere."
