

Neuberger, Smith Show Their Bills

Democrat Maurine Neuberger and Republican Elmo Smith disclosed Monday night their campaign receipts and expenditures thus far in the race for U.S. senator in Oregon.

A spokesman for Mrs. Neuberger said at Portland that a report filed two days ago with the secretary of the Senate showed receipts of \$78,669 and expenditures of \$72,168.

Spokesmen for Smith said his campaign received \$61,347 prior to filing the report 10 days before the November general election.

The Republican candidate received \$6,500 from persons outside Oregon and \$6,500 from the GOP National Campaign Committee, said three Smith spokesmen—Chairman Howard Somers, Treasurer Sidney Schelsinger and attorney Paul Gerhardt. They said the Neuberger campaign books should be opened and added:

"It must be obvious to anyone who watches television or listens to the radio that Mrs. Neuberger has the most lavish advertising campaign in the history of Oregon politics."

However, Allen Hart, a campaign chairman for Mrs. Neuberger, said contributions from persons in all walks of life had made possible a vigorous campaign at the "lowest cost of any recent Oregon election." He said the unsuccessful Republican candidate in 1956 spent \$266,431 in running for the Senate.

Another Neuberger aide, McDannell Brown, said the Democratic list of contributors is open to the public. He said his organization is not interested in checking Smith's books.

Hart said about \$11,000 contributed to the Neuberger campaign represented proceeds from a luncheon in Washington, D.C.

In other developments in Oregon political races Monday night, Sen. Wayne Morse, D-Ore., spoke at the Wild Horse Grange Hall near Pendleton and urged election of every Democrat running for office in the state.

Morse said he wished President Eisenhower would come to Oregon and look at the state's depressed lumbering industry. Morse said Eisenhower had vetoed two housing bills and thus had hurt lumbering in Oregon.

Morse also said that Sen. John F. Kennedy of Massachusetts will be elected to the presidency by a substantial majority. Kennedy will carry 38 states at the minimum, Morse said.

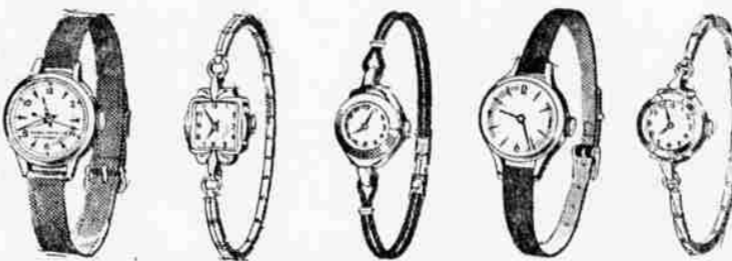
