Of interest to the group was the appointment of Leah Giubrecht to the 8 and 40 Department.

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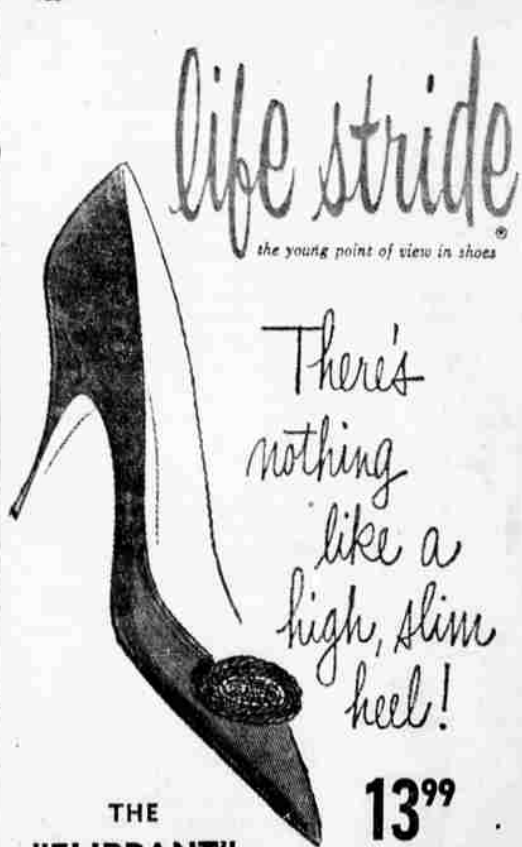


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Ballot Measures Speaker's Topic

STITCH IN TIME

Before laundering his wash-and-wear, leisure or heavy-duty pants, check for points showing wear, and follow the stitch-in-time policy. Even the sturdiest pocket lining eventually gives way to gnawing nuts, bolts, loose change and what-have-you that the adult and small male always manages to collect. When the hole is small, re-stitch the lining with a wider seam. Cut off the excess worn fabric. If it's beyond repair, remove pocket and use as pattern to cut a new pocket from strong cotton twill.



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
