By the way, Chip, there's a dogwood. Where?



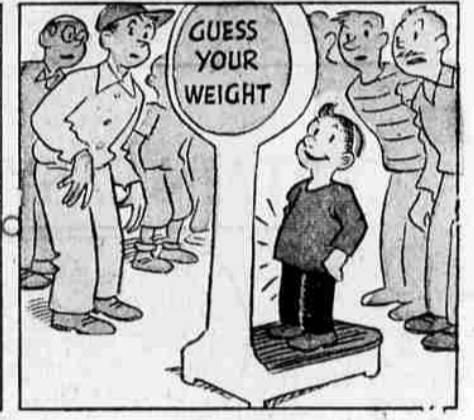
How the dickens would you know what it is, Clovia? Easy, Chip!
