

Jury Awards Woman \$10,000

NEW YORK (AP)—An all-male federal court jury has awarded \$10,000 damages to June Campbell McKee for the embarrassment she suffered when a bellboy entered her hotel room and saw her nude.

Miss McKee, a television producer and writer when it happened six years ago but now an education researcher, won the award Wednesday after the second trial of her suit.

There was testimony that Miss McKee checked into the Sheraton-Russell Hotel on Park Avenue, hung a "Do not disturb" sign on her door and went to bed.

She awakened about 6:15 a.m. and went into the bathroom. When she returned she found a bellboy crouching near her bed. She screamed and tried to cover herself, and got the bellboy to leave. The bellboy contended he thought the room was unoccupied and he was looking for a radio to listen to a baseball game.

"DENNIS THE MENACE" CAB Resumes Searching For Missing Airliner

CAB Resumes Searching For Missing Airliner

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Civil Aeronautics Board has renewed its search for the wreckage of a National Airlines DC7B that crashed in the Gulf of Mexico almost a year ago with a mystery substitute passenger.

A converted mine sweeper, the Hildego, left Galveston, Tex., Saturday loaded with the newest underwater search devices. Until at least some wreckage is recovered, the CAB will be unable to determine whether the plane was sabotaged or crashed for some other reason.

Sabotage was suspected on the Tampa to New Orleans flight Nov. 16, 1959. All 36 passengers and five crew members died. No trace of the plane ever has been found, except for an oil slick and small debris.

Dash of Mystery

A dash of mystery was added to the crash when Robert Spears, self-proclaimed naturopath with a criminal record dating back to World War I, who was supposed to be on the plane, was found alive later in Arizona.

The estranged wife of William Allen Taylor, a Tampa salesman, claimed Spears had hypnotized her husband into taking the flight. Taylor took out \$37,000 in airline insurance nine minutes before the plane departed although his name was not on the passenger list.

Explosives were reported to have been found in Spears' luggage when he was arrested in Phoenix.

Spears, 85, was sentenced to five years for taking Taylor's car from Florida to Arizona. He was given a one to five year sentence in Los Angeles, to be served at the end of the car term, for performing illegal surgery.

Donald Loomis, Spears' co-defendant in the Los Angeles abortion trial, claimed that Spear's

Tug Is Bombed, Five Injured

YOKOSUKA, Japan (UPI)—A U.S. Navy plane engaged in exercises with the 7th Fleet accidentally dropped a bomb close to an American sea-going tug Friday, the Navy disclosed Saturday. Five crewmen were injured.

Boatswain's Mate 3C Jeff L. Holden, 29, Tampa, Fla., suffered a ruptured eardrum and a neck sprain when he tried to protect a shipmate aboard the USS Cree from the explosion. The other four men suffered concussions.

Holden was reported in "very good condition" at Yokosuka naval hospital today. The others were not hospitalized.

The Cree suffered minor damage. Navy officials began investigating the incident.

Q. I had dreadful morning nausea with my first child. Is there anything new about this? I am pregnant again.

A. The basic principles of management of nausea and vomiting in early pregnancy have changed very little in recent years. Doctors prescribe mild sedatives, encourage a diet rich in carbohydrates and low in fats, and suggest taking frequent small, dry, meals. Fluids should be taken separately. Certain drugs are also employed, not always with success.

Q. I was recently a patient in our local hospital. One night I had a splitting headache but the nurse wouldn't even give me an aspirin tablet. I think it was just plain laziness on her part. Do you agree?

A. Sorry, but we don't agree. Hospital nurses give patients only what the doctor has ordered. The reason? He must know that only the drugs he feels will help the patient have been administered. If others are given, even such simple drugs as aspirin, he may
