Bill Bianchi — good speed; played a lot of offensive halfback.

Bob Burnett — came along well as a linebacker; held regular job from mid-season on.

Bruce Campbell — good blocker; was also very adequate on defense.

Ron Coleman — turned out late, and was hampered by injuries but gave the indication of becoming a good lineman.

Don Christy — good two-way performer in the line.

Grover Dahn — one of our most versatile players; did well at all back field posts.

Jon Elliott — ran the ball club well and was a good ground gainer himself.

Rich Flynn — dependable and gained experience as the season progressed.

Mike Gallagher — hard worker; came along toward the end of the season.

Ken Galloway — improved into a very dependable center.

Bob Graham — hard worker; despite size handicap he showed outstanding desire.

Thurston Henzel — was a two regular and one of our outstanding prospects.

Ron Hitchcock — leading scorer and excellent blocker and ball carrier.

Rick Horn — good receiver at end as well as holding the job as a regular defensive back.

Jim Kurth — top defensive end and more than adequate on offense.

Gordy Malcomb — was a real competitor and leader at quarterback; a fine place — kicker and punter.

Daryl Metcalf — did excellent job at tackle both offensively and defensively.

Gary Niemi — improved into a semi-regular linebacker.

Larry Miller — was good all around performer game after game; he will be heard from in the future.

John Otterbein — good fader and pass receiver from his end spot.

Elroy Paulson — good defensive blaster who did more than an adequate job at offensive end.

Fred Reyes — showed fine spirit and determination to continually improve himself.

Ken Puckett — dependable blocker and worked hard all season.

Brian Routh — another fine prospect; he showed lots of knowledge at the tackle slot.

John Ruger — excellent kicker and regular center, who also came along well.

Bud Thompson — showed vast improvement and turned into a fine running back.

Bud Wolter — powerful ball carrier and hit with real authority on defense.

NEW YORK — Trans-Way (\$14.90) and Gawnin (\$9.80) won the two divisions of the Old Brookville Purse at Aqueduct.

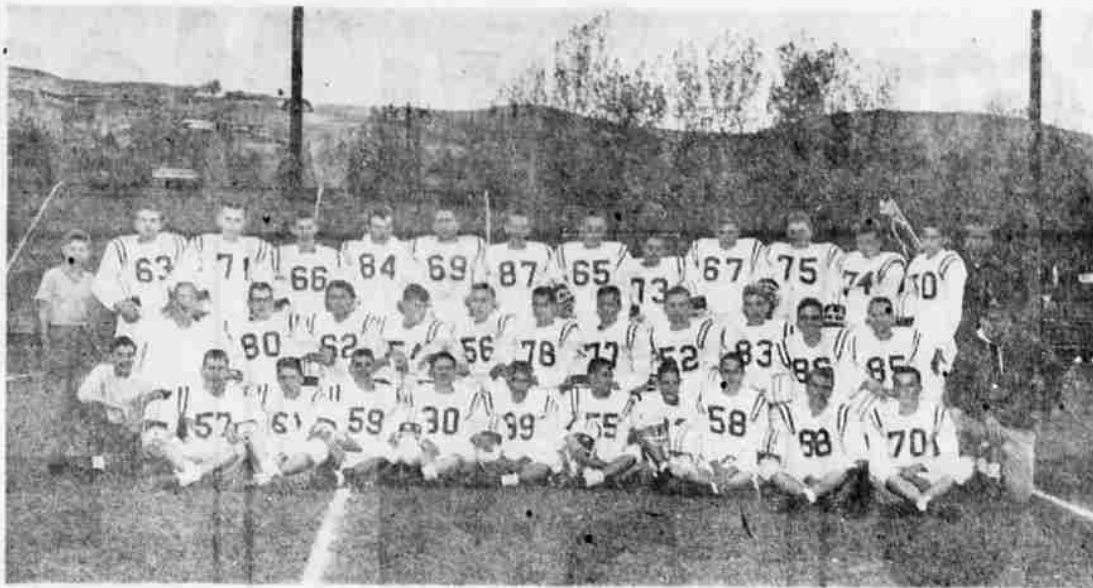

Lebrasseur also plays intramural basketball and is an excellent swimmer. His major is in business, with a minor in education.

AIC Football Coach Gay Salvucci has this to say about his crack linebacker and kickoff man:

"We're all very proud of Gerry — he's a fine leader and a tremendous inspiration to the rest of the players. He goes all out in every game, fundamentally a very sound football player. He can tackle with the best of 'em and is a very good kicker."
