Oregon Republicans Holding Hopes For Organizing State's Lower House

SALEM (AP) — Republicans have hopes that they might organize the 1961 state House of Representatives, despite a 31-29 Democratic majority.

If they do, they would elect the speaker and choose the committee chairmen.

The GOP hopes rest on persuading a couple of Democrats to throw in their lot with the Republicans in organizing the House.

There are four Democratic members, all from Eastern Oregon, who customarily vote with the Republicans on issues which divide the parties. They are Reps. George Annala, Hood River; Don McKinnis, Summerville; Katherine Musa, The Dalles; and Emil Stunz, Nyssa.

Annala has made it known in the past that he wants to be speaker.

Rep. Robert B. Duncan, D-Medford, speaker in 1959, said Thursday he would be willing to be speaker again if the Democrats organize the House. He added he is confident the Democrats will organize it.

Duncan would be the first man ever to serve as speaker in two successive regular sessions.

The Republican choice could be Rep. Robert L. Elstrom, R-Salem. But he underwent surgery

Thursday night for a perforated ulcer.

If there has to be a compromise candidate, it could well be Annala. Or he might be the Republican choice if the GOP gets an outright majority in the vote on organization.

At any rate the Republicans probably will run the House when it comes to voting on issues which divide the parties. That's because of the four Democratic votes they can count on, which give them 33 of the 60 votes.

The Republicans have stuck together solidly in voting during the past two sessions in which they have been the minority party.

In the 1959 session when the

Democrats held a 33-27 edge, they could not muster a voting majority when the chips were down.

In the Senate the Democrats have a 20-10 majority.

The legislature meets Jan. 9.

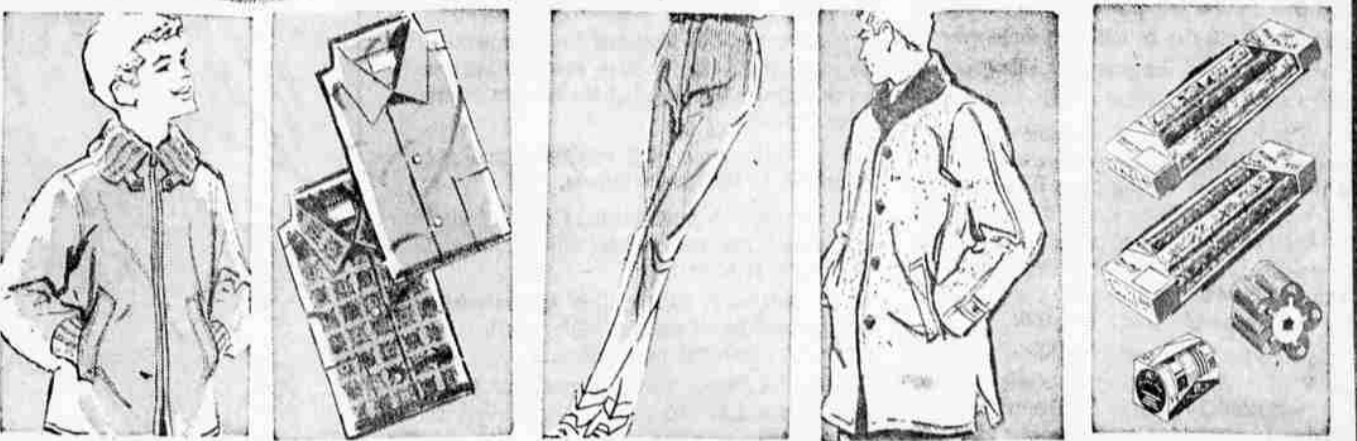

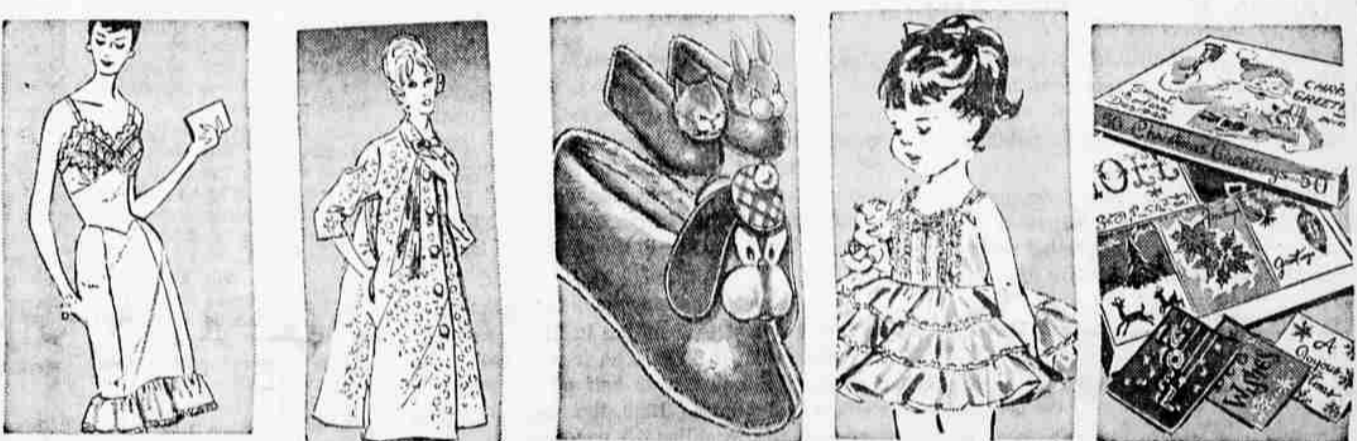
