THE CASE OF THE DOOMED ARSONIST

WHEN JACK Freeman, a coat manufacturer, doubled the fire insurance on his New York City warehouse, the insurance company was curious. The matter was referred to the National Board of Fire Underwriters for investigation by its arson squad.
