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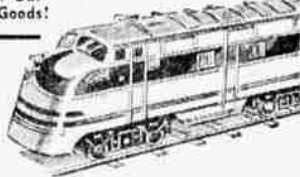
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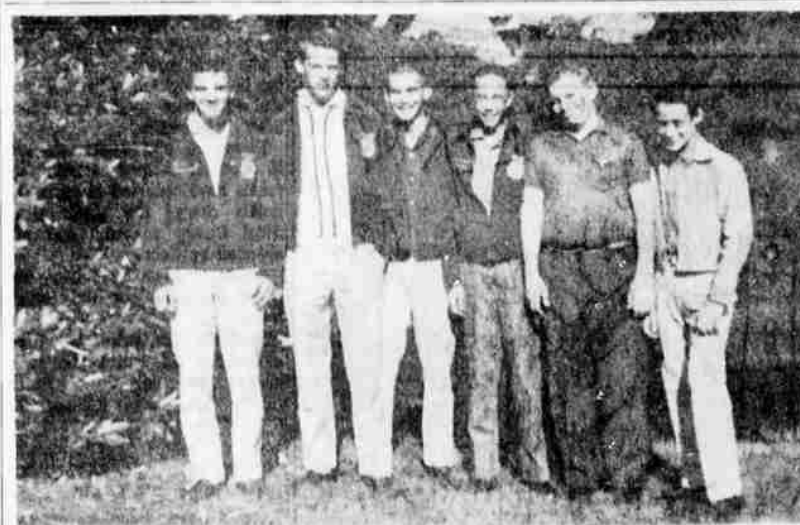

Student council representatives met following school last Thursday afternoon to discuss, among other things, the recent homecoming activities.

Several members, including president George Vinson, criticized homecoming as not being completely organized and lacking student enthusiasm. However, all agreed the event was largely a success.

Some suggested that the homecoming queen should be nominated by the lettermen's club and elected by the entire student body or by Boy's Alliance. She is presently nominated and elected by the lettermen's club.

Predicts Farm Number Decline

DENVER (AP) — The bulk of the food and fiber consumed in this country by the end of the 1960s will come from fewer than a half-million farms, an Oregon State College professor predicted Monday.

Dr. G. B. Wood, head of the Department of Agricultural Economics at Oregon State, told the ninth annual National Agricultural Conference that "86 per cent of our farms produce only 9 per cent of our farm products."

He added that this country loses a farm "about every five minutes due to the changing nature of agriculture and the revolutionary forces at work."

"In the 1960s we should anticipate legislation at the state and national level which will provide modified programs of collective bargaining for agriculture similar to what we have today for labor," he said at the conference, which is sponsored by the American Bankers Association.

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
