

Owl Lineman Rates All-Coast Mention

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—Humboldt State of California and Willamette of Oregon grabbed the lion's share of honors in the 1960 United Press International Little All-Coast football team announced today.

Among players receiving Honorable Mention for their work during the season was Oregon Tech's Jim Madden, a 232-pound tackle from Oakland, California. Madden, who displays amazing speed and agility for a man his size, went both ways for the undefeated Techmen.

Humboldt State, Far West Conference champion, and Willamette, Northwest Conference king, both went through the season undefeated and each placed three men on the all-star team. San Francisco State and Fresno State, the other two small school powerhouses of the West, each took two places. The other went to Whitworth.

The all-star first-team backfield is made up of Fred Whitmore, Humboldt State; Charley Fuller, San Francisco State; Dale Messer, Fresno State; and Stan Solomon, Willamette.

Whitmore was the signal-caller and passer who led Humboldt State to its best season in history. Fuller, a smashing runner who is

Civilian Ref Nixes Banner On Pentagon

WASHINGTON (AP)—Down went a big "Beat Army" sign from above a Pentagon entrance. Down went a "Beat Navy" sign from a Pentagon fence.

A civilian referee stepped in Wednesday to cool off the growing interservice rivalry in advance of Saturday's Army-Navy football game in Philadelphia.

"The signs were not in keeping with the dignity of the establishment," explained John J. Province, the civilian business manager of the Pentagon. "For a college campus—yes; but for headquarters of the Defense Department . . . it was something entirely different."

Province's order didn't dampen the Navy spirit for long. A short time after the "Beat Army" sign was ordered off the Pentagon grounds, it was flapping from the main Navy Building on the other side of the Potomac River.

And the guards are just as powerful. Doug Brown of Fresno State and Mary Cisneros of Willamette already have been looked over by the professionals.

Center position went to Willie Hartman, 220-pounder from Willamette.

Phil Sarboe, who lifted Humboldt State from a perennial also-ran to a top Western small school power in recent years, is named as Coach of the Year. Brown wins the honors as Lineman of the Year and Fuller as Back of the Year.

Named to the second team were Carey, Los Angeles State, and Gregory, Whittier, ends; Townsend, Central Washington, and Puckett, Los Angeles State, tackles; Heskett, Sacramento State, and Austin, Willamette, guards; Pollock, Humboldt State, center; Light, Pacific University, White, Humboldt State, Lum, Hawaii, and Simpson, San Francisco State, backs.

Yank Teeners Finish Rout

BRISBANE, Australia (AP)—Teen-age Dennis Ralston and Chuck McKinley, brightest of America's tennis hopefuls, completed a 5-0 rout of the Philippines today in the Davis Cup interzone semifinals.

Playing in substitute roles after clinching the series with a doubles victory Wednesday, they trounced top-ranking Philippine stars who were pulled off the bench for the final day's play.

First Ralston, the 18-year-old Bakersfield, Calif., schoolboy, smashed the reigning Philippine national champion, Raymundo Deyro, 6-2, 6-0, 7-5.

McKinley, 19, from St. Louis, outlasted 40-year-old Felicissimo Ampon, 13 times Philippine champion, 6-4, 3-6, 6-4, 6-2.

The Americans qualified to play Italy in the interzone finals at Perth, Western Australia, Dec. 9-11.

Deyro's smashing defeat at the hands of 18-year-old Ralston substantiated the decision by Philippine captain Al Del Rio in using youngsters Johnny Jose and Eddie Dingo in place of the older but higher-ranked players.

Jose and Dingo bowed in the opening singles to Earl Buchholz and Barry MacKay respectively and lost in the doubles Wednesday to Ralston and McKinley. Nevertheless they gave a good account of themselves.

'What's The Word, Mister?' - 'Beat Navy, Sir!'

WEST POINT (AP)—Joe Bellino is the pin-up boy of the Army post this week. His likeness hangs literally on the barracks walls.

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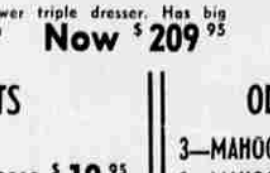
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
