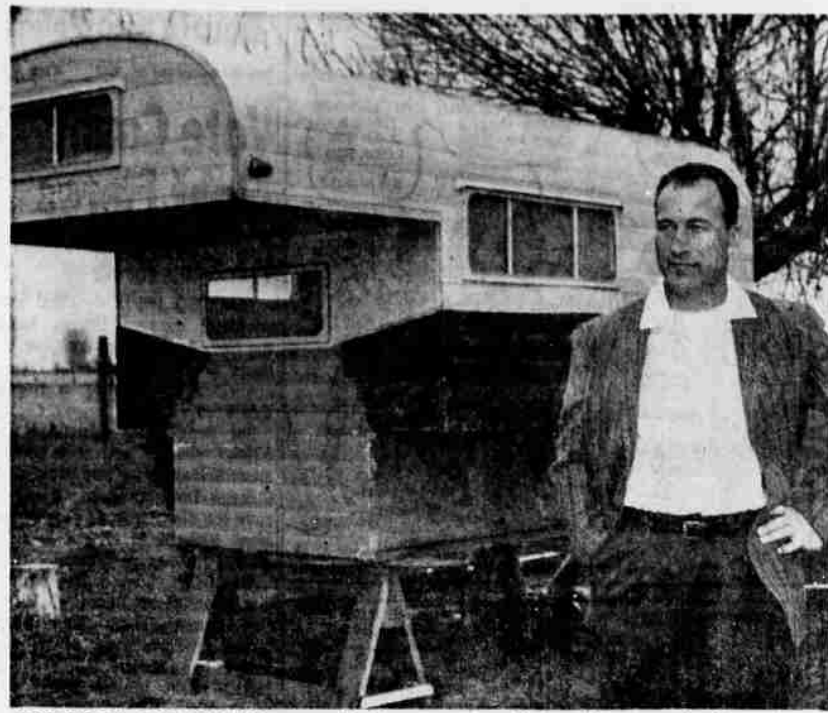

OLCC Rules On Closure

PORTLAND (AP) — The Oregon Liquor Control Commission decided Wednesday that beer taverns must continue to close at 1 a.m.

The commission rejected a request that taverns be permitted to remain open until 2:30 a.m. the same time that bars close.

Hugh Kirkpatrick, chairman of the commission, said: "It is our belief there has not been demonstrated sufficient cause for a change in any of the existing hours of operation."

The commission announced also that liquor stores will close at 6 p.m. on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve as they have for the past three years.

Administrator George Van Vergen reported that liquor sales last month were down 7 per cent compared to October, 1959. He did not speculate on the reason for the decline.
