State Fair Does Well

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon State Fair Commission reported Tuesday that 1960 was a record money-making year for the fair with final audits showing a \$107,432 profit.

Last year a \$66,000 profit was turned.

The commission put the 1961 State Fair into motion during an all-day meeting that saw several major appointments and contracts approved.

These included Mrs. C. N. Rundell, Portland, art director; West Coast Shows carnival contract, Christensen Brothers, Eugene, nine-day rodeo; Al Lightner, Salem racing director; Melvin Geist, music dean at Willamette University, in charge of an Oregon talent troupe to present free shows.

A medical source said there was "naturally some concern" and indicated Dooley will undergo tests.

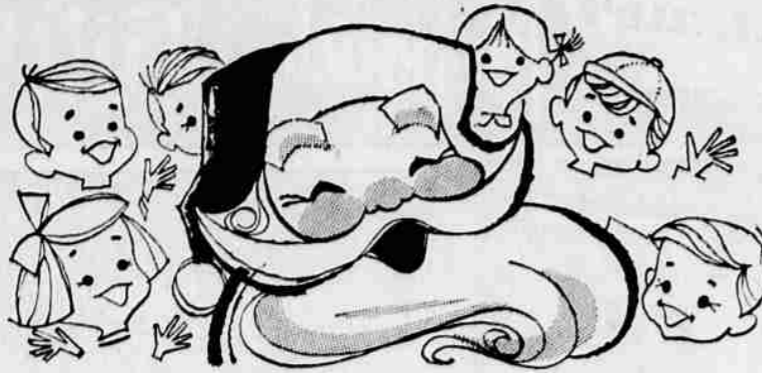
Tax Total Up

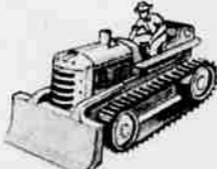
