

Hunting Fraternity May Suffer For Vandalistic Actions Few

A postcard sent out last month to all members of the Oregon Catmen's Association is a sort of a blanket indictment of the hunting fraternity in general. And may be a portent of dire things to come in the future unless prompt steps are taken to correct the situation.

The card wants to know how much hunter damage was suffered by the member during the year. Spaces are provided for the property and livestock damage totals as well as a space for comment.

I can well imagine what some of these comments would be. I'm sure that at least a few of them will prove abusive to type and may well scorch the card.

I know that it is a sad commentary on the times when it is necessary that such cards be sent out. And I also know that when

such cards are found necessary the hunting fraternity has been pushed that much closer to the brink. That the end of free hunting is brought a step closer.

I belong to the hunting crowd. And yet I can only agree with the catmen, the farmers and the landowners when they take precautionary steps to either prevent vandalism on their lands or arrange some sort of reparation for it after it occurs.

I believe that the biggest fly in the ointment is the rose-tinted apathy on the part of the hunters in general. I don't think that a lot of the responsible ones realize how bleak the outlook is.

Of course we all know that the damage to land, stock and personal property is brought about by a mighty small percentage of the hunters. There are a few bad apples in every barrel. I wouldn't want to guess at a percentage figure, but it would be low. The

average hunter is a pretty fair sort of gentleman and vandalism is the furthest thing from his mind. But a handful of his fellows are not so well adjusted.

Here are just a few of the things I have seen this year that would bring the blood pressure of any landowner up in the paint cards: I have seen deer camps on privately owned land that looked like garbage dumps with tin cans, paper plates, whiskey bottles, beer cans and other rubbish left lying around where it fell. I saw not long ago a sign welcoming hunters to a large privately owned area but warning of fire danger—a sign that had been deliberately blasted full of fist-sized holes with a shotgun.

I watched one hunter through my glasses while he deliberately chopped a locked gate open and drove through. Had he been close enough for me to get his license number he would have been turned in. I have seen at least a half dozen locks that have been shot off gates. I don't know how many fences I've seen that were stretched and broken from hunters climbing over them. I have watched men and dogs sally into a wheat field before harvest and shatter grain all over the place.

I have seen deer banks torn down and weakened by thoughtless hunters driving onto them and getting stuck. And the count on open gates is beyond estimation. Not to mention the shot out windows, the shot up water tanks and the annual reports from timber operators who find tires shot off heavy equipment.

All these things are going to spell the end of free hunting one of these days. If the tide of destruction continues the hunters are going to find themselves faced with pay-as-you-go hunting on privately operated game

ranges. And that isn't going to set well with them.

Is there anything that we can do to prevent all this? Yes; certainly there is, but it isn't going to be easy. And it isn't going to happen overnight.

First, the hunters are going to have to take a fresh look at their attitudes about taking care of the land. As individuals the hunting club are going to have to act as policemen. No one likes to "turn in" another hunter or butt in on what he's doing. Even when they know it is wrong. But it is going to have to be done. If the hunters can't clean up their own situation then it is inevitable that it will be cleaned up for them. And that is going to hurt.

There are going to have to be further efforts made at better hunter-landowner relationships. That can be done only through intelligent education and cooperation.

There will have to be increased vigilance on the part of the sportsmen's organizations to see to it that their side is presented to the non-sporting public in a favorable manner. And a closer check kept on anti-gun bills that play into the hands of the minority pressure groups.

As I said earlier, the one thing that is most damaging of all is the apparent lethargy of the average sportsman. He is all-out to pooh-pooh the idea that his hunting is threatened. The other fellow's, maybe, but not his.

Brother, it just ain't so.

And it can happen here.

It is said that a word to the wise is sufficient. I hope that there are both enough words and enough wise sportsmen to add up to a happy ending. But that ending won't come about if the sportsman continues to insulate himself with false facts and defend his position as a do-nothing.

Amateur Fighters To Show

Klamath Falls area boxing fans get three chances to watch top amateurs perform within the next three weeks, it was learned today.

This Saturday, in the Chiloquin High School gym, the Chiloquin Boys Club, under the direction of Police Chief Lou Jones, will play host to a contingent of young fighters from the Knott Street (Portland) Community Center. The fighters will appear in a special card to be held at Kingsley Field. Also slated to appear on the Kingsley card are some able performers from the Air Base itself.

On Thursday, Dec. 22, a squad of scrappers from the Burns PAL Club, one of the top amateur organizations in the West, will appear as part of a big Oregon Tech benefit show slated for the Klamath Falls Auditorium. Jones will serve as matchmaker for all three programs.

Saturday's Chiloquin bouts will feature return engagements for four recently-crowned Oregon novice champions against the fighters with which they won the titles.

Bert Farris, 125 pounds; Bob Bjorjaces, 165; Roland Cume, 147, and Ray DeBortoli, 100, all from the Chiloquin Boys Club, will give their original title opponents another chance Saturday. Each of the foes is from the Knott Street Club, an organization that includes over 200 amateur fighters.

The Portland squad is under the direction of Dave Peters who is assisted by a corps of six coaches. Jones is assisted in handling the Chiloquin youth by Ernie Krauss.

Tickets to the Chiloquin show are available now. Admission charges are \$1 for adults and 50 cents for youngsters. Fight time is 8 p.m.

The Oregon Tech card on the 22nd will feature, among eight fighters coming in from Burns, a Rocky Mountain amateur champion, and other fighters who have entered the national amateur competition.

One of the local favorites who will draw a match on the card is Jake Gregg, a fast-moving 120-pounder.
