

November Weather Breaks Records

DUNSMUIR—November weather in southern Siskiyou County broke two all-time records according to the United States Weather Bureau station at Mount Shasta. The heaviest early snowfall of the season since 1888 when record-

keeping started in this area was recorded on Nov. 13 when Mount Shasta had a snow depth of 11 inches. The total snowfall for the month was 28.1 inches, another record for the past 72 years. The previous November snowfall

record was 26.2 inches in 1955. The two-day storm which marked the end of the month established a record for a 24-hour period. Five and seventeen-hundredths inches of rain fell from 5 p.m. on Nov. 30 to 5 p.m. on Dec. 1. Storm statistics on a 24-hour basis were not compiled before 1949 so no comparative figures are available before that year.

High winds also contributed to the November weather picture with 60-mile winds recorded at Mount Shasta on Nov. 24 and up to 80-mile winds at Weed during the same storm.

Total precipitation for the month in Mount Shasta was 8.39 inches, compared with a normal of 3.83 inches. Weed reported a total of 8.95 inches; McCloud, 14.90; Dunsmuir, 15.31; Castella, 16.42.

The Mt. Shasta Ski Bowl reported a total of 15.78 inches of rainfall bringing a snowfall of 150 inches. At the close of the month the snowpack at the bowl was 96 inches.

The snow level remained above the 4,000-foot level during the heavy storms which came at the latter part of the month which meant the major highways in the area could be traveled without chains.

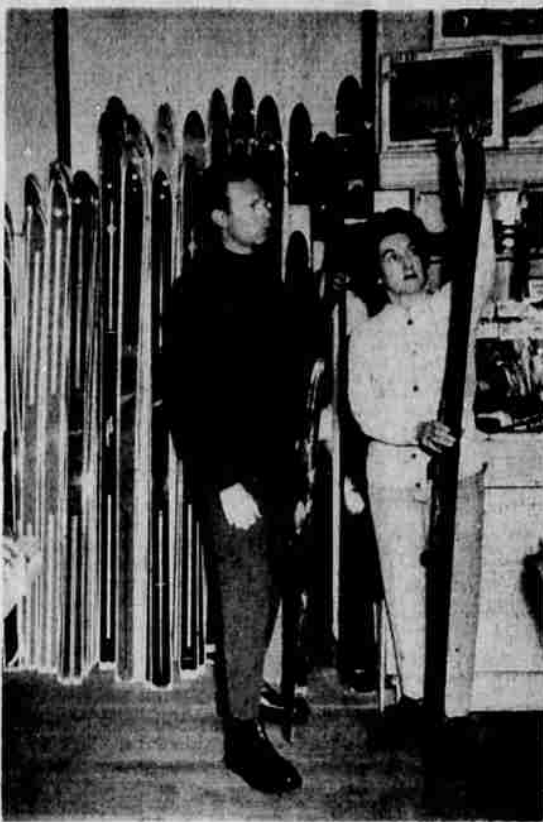
Other weather statistics from the Mount Shasta Weather Bureau station note Nov. 1 as the warmest day with a high of 65 degrees. Weed reported 65 degrees; McCloud, 72; Dunsmuir, 73 and the Ski Bowl 53 on the same day. Nov. 28 was the coldest day in the area, a chilly 21 in Mount Shasta; 17 in McCloud, 27 in Dunsmuir and 14 at the Ski Bowl. Weed's cold days were the 9th, 10th and 22nd of the month with 22 degrees on those days.

The average daily temperature for the month was 39.3 degrees, 2.2 below normal.

Skiing Tickets Will Be Sold

DUNSMUIR—The sale of season tickets to ski enthusiasts was decided upon by the board of directors of the Mt. Shasta Ski Bowl Corporation on Friday.

The tickets will be available at the Mt. Shasta Ski Bowl Lodge as soon as they can be printed according to an announcement by the board. The tickets will entitle holders to unlimited use of the chairlift and other ski facilities. Season tickets for couples and families will be available too on a descending scale according to the number of persons in the family, a board spokesman said.

MONTAGUE — Siskiyou County sheriff's deputies have charged R. B. Ford, 36, a Yreka artist, with assault with a deadly weapon, following a disturbance in a local tavern over the weekend.

Bill Jespersen, the bartender, said Ford threatened him with a gun when he attempted to intervene in an argument in which Ford knocked another customer down, deputies stated.

Deputies later found Ford's auto parked on Yreka-Montague road near the Herman and C. L. Lorini Ranch. They arrested Ford when he returned to the car, they added.

Ford denied having pulled a gun.
