

Schnozzola To Be Wed In New York

HOLLYWOOD (UPI) — Jimmy Durante said today that after a 15-year courtship, a one-year engagement and much hemming and hawing he's going to do it—get married.

The famed 67-year-old comedian with the big nose said he and Margie Little, about 41, will marry Wednesday in New York City. "Geeze," the Schnozzola told United Press International. "I guess it's just about time. I gotta go trew with it now."

Jimmy, speaking in his on-stage dialect, remembered he had announced his engagement to Miss Little, his near constant companion since 1945, in November, 1959. His first wife of 22 years died in 1943.

"Dis is awful," said Durante, "all dis follin' around. Some folks might tink I want publicity or somethin' like dat. It ain't dat at all."

"I just want a quiet wedding—no hullabaloo, no party or nothin'," the beloved entertainer said. "Nice and quiet, dat's how I want it."

Durante said the ceremony would take place at New York's St. Malachy Church with Father Thomas De Luco of Troy, N.Y., performing the rites. The priest is an old friend of Durante.

It will be the first marriage for red-haired Miss Little.

"I finally got someone to lead me around by da nose," cracked Durante of the marriage plans.

Vote Reports Incomplete

WASHINGTON (UPI) — One month after the presidential election, official returns from the 50 states still are incomplete.

The vote from 37 states has been certified as official by their secretaries of state. Canvasses, a few uncounted returns and fraud charges in Illinois are holding up certification in the remaining 14 states.

The unofficial United Press International tabulation today was:

Kennedy—34,193,027
Nixon—34,068,444
Others—474,710
Total—68,736,181.

This gave President-elect John F. Kennedy a slim 124,583 margin over Vice President Richard M. Nixon. Kennedy had 50.091 per cent of the 68,261,471 two-party vote, and Nixon had 49.909 per cent—a difference of 0.182 per cent.

Ships Placed On Latin America Patrol Recalled

WASHINGTON (AP) — U.S. Navy ships that have been on patrol off Guatemala and Nicaragua have been withdrawn, the White House reports.

Will Open Bids

PORTLAND (AP)—The Bureau of Public Roads plans to open bids Dec. 29 on grading 13.2 miles of timber access road in Douglas and Lane counties.

The project will start on Canton Creek Road, about 14 miles north of the highway at Steamboat Creek. From there it will run north to the vicinity of the Lane County line, where it will branch east and west along the Clark Creek Road.

President Eisenhower had ordered the patrol last month in response to requests from Guatemala and Nicaragua. Leaders of the two countries charged that Cuban-backed revolutionaries had taken part in insurrections shortly before the request was made.

The aircraft carrier Shangri-La and four destroyers began the patrol in mid-November. The carrier Wasp replaced the Shangri-La shortly before the end of the month and five destroyers relieved those on duty. Two long-range patrol planes were also assigned to the Western Caribbean.

The Navy said the Wasp was due today at Mayport, Fla., to unload some planes before proceeding to her home port in Boston.

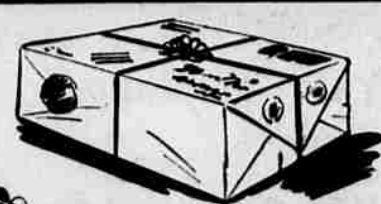
