

Teachers Invited To KUHS

Klamath Union High School is inviting high school and elementary school teachers from all school districts in the county to attend a reading workshop Saturday at KUHS, beginning with registration at 9 a.m.

About 70 teachers have indicated they will attend and C. E. Redfield, KUHS assistant principal who is in charge of workshop planning, says at least 100 are expected.

Dr. Donald E. Moore, assistant professor of English at Southern Oregon College, will deliver the main address and act as workshop consultant.

Theme for the meet is "What the Classroom Teacher Can Do to Improve Student Reading."

Redfield said developmental reading, for students who already are good readers and remedial reading for those who are not, will be discussed.

The meeting is for all teachers, not just those who are concerned primarily with reading training, said Redfield.

"All teachers can help in reading training," he added.

The conference will adjourn about 2:30 p.m. Luncheon will be served in the KUHS cafeteria.

Power System Is Challenged

WASHINGTON (AP)—Adequacy of a power line system plan proposed for Mountain Sheep Dam was challenged by public power attorneys Wednesday at a Power Commission hearing on middle Snake River dam construction.

Marshall L. Blair, vice president of Washington Water Power Co., defended the plan. He said it was adequate for purposes of the hearing, and a more detailed plan will be worked out later.

Washington Water Power is one of several northwest electric utility firms, joined together as Pacific Northwest Power Co., which are seeking authority to build the Mountain Sheep project.

Washington Public Power Supply System proposed to build a dam at the Nez Perce site instead.

Attorneys for the public power group argued that the PNP plan had been used in a previous Power Commission case.

Farmers Told Need To Adjust

CORVALLIS (AP) — A farm conference at Oregon State College Tuesday was told agriculture must adjust to a rapidly changing society, rather than attempt to stop it.

J. Carroll Bottum, assistant head of the Agricultural Economics Department at Purdue University, told the annual conference of the OSC research, extension and instruction staff that agriculture suffers from an excess of labor. He said five out of six farm youths would move to non-farm jobs.

Bottum proposed that 40 to 80 million acres of cultivated land be taken out of production are more management resources are put into agriculture for higher efficiency.
