

Bomb Shatters Car Of Key Witness

ELIZABETH, N.J. (UPI) — An apparent time bomb shattered the automobile today of a key government witness in the jailing last summer of a teamsters official for tax evasion, authorities reported. It was the second attempt on the life of William P. Hillbrant, treasurer of the Neo-Gravure Printing Co., Weehawken, N.J. Hillbrant was in his house when the blast ripped his car to a mass of jagged metal. Police said the explosion occurred minutes before Hillbrant's wife, Dorothy, was to drive her husband to the Weehawken plant. The car was registered in Mrs. Hillbrant's name. Hillbrant does not drive. The bombing was described by police as the work of a professional. It was planted under the front seat of the car on the driver's side. Hillbrant was the chief government witness last August at the trial of Harold (The Weasel) Gross, who was convicted and sentenced to three years in prison for tax evasion. The attorney testified at the trial that he handed Gross six payments of \$4,000 each and two of \$2,000 each between 1953 and 1958 to prevent labor trouble in the delivery of the "American Weekly," Hearst newspapers Sunday supplement, from the Weehawken plant.

Hollywood Stars To Aid Demos

HOLLYWOOD (UPI) — Peter Lawford, brother-in-law of President-elect John F. Kennedy, said today he and Frank Sinatra will produce a show to clean up the \$2 million Democratic campaign deficit. Lawford and Sinatra will be joined by Sammy Davis Jr., Tony Curtis and Janet Leigh, Shirley MacLaine, Harry Belafonte, Milton Berle, Nat (King) Cole and Dean Martin in the preinaugural show Jan. 19 in the National Armory at Washington. "The Democrats spent \$9 million on the campaign," Lawford said, "and are \$2 million in debt." "This show, a special revue, will bail them out. We will net more than \$1.9 million on the basis of tickets already sold. The armory seats 14,000. "We've already sold out the 72 boxes, which seat 10 people, at \$10,000 a box," Lawford continued. "This will be the biggest take in show business history for a one-nighter."
