DALLAS, Tex. (AP) — The battle for passing supremacy in the American Football League has ended up a two-man duel between Jack Kemp of Los Angeles and Frank Tripucka of Denver.

The third-place slot was captured by Al Dorow of New York who had the finest game of the season last week. He hit 29 of 48 attempts, gave up no interceptions and gained 375 yards.

Kemp is still leading with an efficiency point total of 46 1/2 to 43 1/2 for Tripucka, and 42 1/2 for Dorow.
