

Knighthood Is In Flower

NEW YORK—Knighthood is in flower again, but in reverse — it's the girls who wear the knightly tunics.

The Camelot look is sweeping the country with two-tone tights, shock color topover blouses, heraldic jewelry, little caps and pointy shoes bringing all the pageantry of King Arthur's court.

Velvety fabrics, crusading color schemes and page-boy silhouettes provide the medieval look in sparsely cut tops. Horizontally striped velvet is cut into a straight and narrow, mid-thigh-length bishop's coat. A turnabout tunic puts up a shocking pink front, an orange back. Velveteen pants split honors with split-personality tights, a different color for each leg.

An extension of the Camelot look comes in with tunic sweaters to knit yourself. All are over-blouses in wild colors and are easy to make.

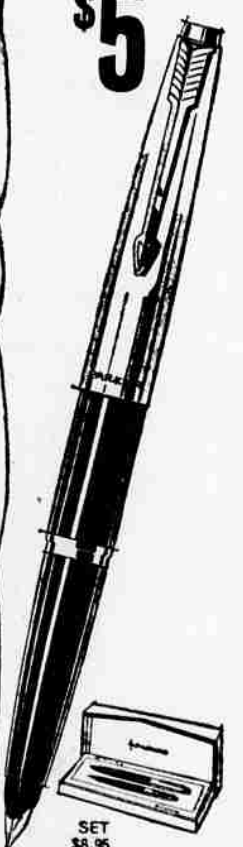
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
