Once inside, they took a petty cash box containing about \$1 and about \$15 worth of postage stamps.

They also took a set of keys to all the unit's doors. Investigation is continuing.

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — William Vance, 40, a temporary postman, found the Christmas mail rush too exasperating.

People kept telling him he was delivering mail to the wrong address, and it "confused and upset" him. So he threw pieces of mail down a sewer, he told a U.S. commissioner at a hearing Monday. Most of it looked like Christmas cards anyway, he added.

The mail was recovered and after being dried out will be delivered.

Vance was held in \$500 bail.

By 1965, aluminum is expected to be used in home building at an annual rate of 1 1/2 billion pounds, more than double last year's use.

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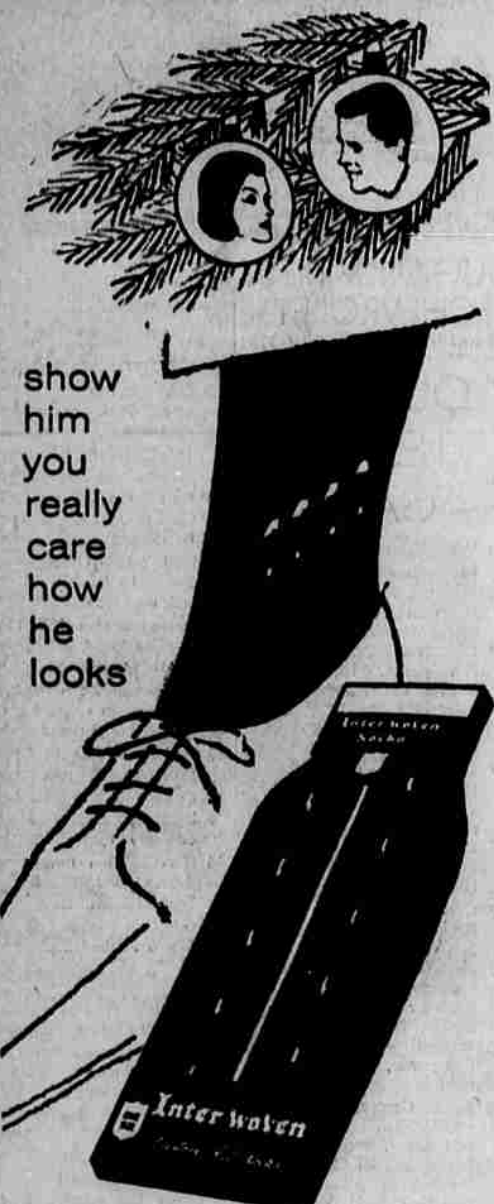
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
