Fertilizer Use Up In Oregon

SALEM (AP) — The state Department of Agriculture said Wednesday that Oregon farmers bought more fertilizer for their land in the third quarter of 1960 than in the corresponding period of 1959.

The department said that more than 35,000 tons of fertilizer were sold in Oregon from July 1 to Sept. 30. This was 6,000 tons greater than the amount sold in the same period of 1959.

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
