

# 'Lights On For Education' Panel Will Be Presented Thursday Night

Panelists and committee members are busy making final preparations for the "Lights On For Education" program to be presented Thursday at 7:45 p.m. in Altamont Junior High School.

## BIG PROBLEMS

## RIVERS FLOODING

PARIS (AP) — Rain-swollen rivers in central France poured over their banks Tuesday taking at least five lives and causing widespread property damage.

In the Loire and Indre departments farm houses were being evacuated. At Saint Patern some 90 families were reported cut off by flood waters.

Panelists include Carrol Howe, state representative - elect from Klamath County and former superintendent of county schools; Francis Skinner, 4-H Club leader and chairman of the Klamath County Committee on Children and Youth; Harvey Denham, principal of Altamont Junior High and legislative chairman for the Klamath County Unit, Oregon Education Association; and Mrs. L. E. Saunders Jr., president of Altamont Parent Teacher Association and legislative chairman for the Klamath Council of Parents and Teachers.

Each will speak for about 15 minutes, then the session will be opened to questions from the audience. Their subject will be matters concerning education and child welfare that will be considered by the state legislature during the coming session. The public is asked to come.

The program is a statewide project to focus attention on and stimulate interest in "many vital education and youth legislative measures." It is sponsored by the Oregon Congress of Parents and Teachers, the Oregon Education Association and the Oregon School Boards Association.

All schools in the suburban area of the city are cooperating in planning and presenting the program. They are Altamont Elementary and Altamont Junior High schools, Henley Elementary and Henley High schools, Keno, Ferguson, Fairhaven, Falcon Heights, Peterson, Shasta and Stearns schools.

Independent meetings of a similar nature will be featured in the city and in schools outside it. The latter meetings are in planning stage by administrations and parent teacher organizations of the respective schools.

A meeting also featuring four panelists will be conducted in Mills School to accommodate residents of the city, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

Throughout the state lights will be turned on in schools simultaneously for a portion of the evening as a gesture symbolic of the project theme. The program is the first of what is hoped to be a biennial series conducted on the eve of every state legislative session.
