DILL FLAVORED TANGY SALAD

TART 'n' TANGY FRUIT SALAD
 1 (one pound 14 ounce) can fruit cocktail
 1 teaspoon dried dill
 1/2 teaspoon grated lemon rind
 Salad greens
 Homemade Dressing
HOMEMADE DRESSING
 Fruit syrup
 1/2 cup cider vinegar
 1/4 cup flour
 1/2 teaspoon dry mustard
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1 egg, slightly beaten
 Combine fruit cocktail, dill and lemon rind and chill for two to three hours. Drain and reserve syrup; heap fruit on crisp salad greens. Pass Homemade Dressing.

HOMEMADE Dressing: Combine syrup drained from fruit cocktail with vinegar, flour, mustard and salt. Stir until smooth. Cook and stir until mixture boils and is thickened. Slowly stir egg into hot mixture. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until thickened. Remove from heat and cool thoroughly.
 Makes five to six servings.

SHOO FLY PIE

That hearty Pennsylvania Dutch dessert, Shoo Fly Pie, gets the California treatment and comes to the table all dressed up with fresh sun-ripened dates. Try it and you'll agree that "Date Shoo Fly Pie" is simply delicious!

To make this date-laden sweet, arrange alternate layers of spicy crumb mixture and lemon-y molasses over the chopped fruit in a pastry lined pan. The flavors join together to make a lush, luscious holiday dessert. It's rich; it's definitely not for dieters, but it is a terrific dinner party finale.

DATE SHOO FLY PIE

Pastry for one (9-inch) pie shell
 1 1/2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
 1/2 cup brown sugar (packed)
 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 1/4 cup shortening
 2-3 cup light molasses
 2-3 cup hot water
 1/4 teaspoon soda
 1 1/2 teaspoons grated lemon rind
 1 cup pitted, chopped fresh California dates
 Line 9-inch pie pan with pastry. Blend flour, brown sugar, cinnamon and salt together; cut in shortening until pieces are the size of small peas. Blend molasses, hot water, soda and lemon rind together. Sprinkle a thin layer of crumb mixture in bottom of unbaked pie shell and cover with dates. Alternate layers of molasses mixture and crumbs on top of dates, ending with crumbs. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 45 minutes. Pie is done when silver knife inserted halfway between outer rim and center of filling comes out clean. Cool before serving.
 Makes one (9-inch) pie.

GAY UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

Combine California cling peach and New England cranberries in a handsome upside-down cake. Melt 1/4 cup butter in bottom of 9 x 13-inch cake pan. Arrange drained canned cling peach slices in butter. Mix 3 cups uncooked cranberries with 1 cup sugar and pour over peaches. Prepare your easiest recipe for white cake or use packaged mix. Pour batter over fruits and bake in moderate oven about 40 minutes. Turn out upside down and serve "as is" or with whipped cream or ice cream.

Old-time cooks sometimes flavored their gingerbread cakes and cookies with lemon. Quick-order modern cooks can bake a package of gingerbread mix and frost it with confectioners' sugar moistened with lemon juice and add a little grated lemon rind.
