**HIGHWAY REPORT**

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Rep. Samuel Stratton, D-N.Y., has suggested that President-elect John F. Kennedy invite the presidents of Central and South American republics to meet in Washington later this year to promote cordial relations.

Such a meeting, Stratton said Monday, would enable Kennedy to capitalize on a "tremendous feeling of friendliness" toward him in Latin America.

Here are the election rules:  
1. The president's nominating committee picks at least six members as candidates for the board of directors and three are elected to serve for three years.  
2. Other nominations may be made from the floor or by filing the candidates' names with the secretary.  
3. Ballots are mailed a few days in advance of the voting deadline, on the fourth Monday of January each year.

Reports by committee chairmen summarizing the year's activities will also be heard during the meeting.
