Weed Has First Council Meeting; Kersey Mayor

WEED — This city's new government was set in motion during the first official city council meeting Friday evening, Jan. 27.

Councilmen took an oath administered by Rachel Cordes, county clerk, and Judge Kenneth T. Stone of the Weed Justice Court.

J. I. (Jack) Kersey was named mayor. He was elected by the new council. Melvin Soletti is vice mayor, Robert Bailey, city clerk; Harold W. Campbell, treasurer, and David Dawson, chief of police.

Mrs. Harvey (Madelon) Gilman was appointed deputy city clerk, and William Heidewald, city attorney.

The Rev. E. A. Mellon of Mount Shasta Baptist Church of Weed opened ceremonies with the invocation. More than 100 county officials and residents attended. The Rev. Keith Reed of Glad Tidings Assembly Church delivered the benediction.

The council passed 18 ordinances, resolutions and agreements providing for execution of bonds, providing for adoption of an official seal, setting the meeting time and place on the first Thursday of each month at 7:30 p.m. in Weed Courthouse, 27 Gilman Avenue, and designating places for posting ordinances.

The council created provisions for general and traffic safety funds and a general financial framework, and allowed for the city taxes to be collected by the county tax collector.

Putnam Given Big Ovation

SALEM (AP) — State Superintendent of Public Instruction Rex Putnam, who retired Tuesday after serving since 1937, was given a rising ovation by the Oregon State Senate yesterday.

With Putnam seated on the rostrum, Sen. Monroe Sweetland, D-Milwaukie, chairman of the Senate Education Committee, said Putnam was largely responsible for Oregon having the best school system in the nation.

Sen. Eddie Ahrens, R-Turner, recalled that Putnam had been his teacher at Salem High School. Leon Minear, principal of Benson High School in Portland, will be sworn in Wednesday. He was named by Gov. Mark O. Hatfield to succeed Putnam.
