Russ-Banded Geese Bagged

PORTLAND (AP)—Three snow geese, shot near Summer Lake in Southeastern Oregon last fall, had been banded earlier by the Russian Commission for Nature Protection at Wrangell Island. Wrangell Island is about 100 miles north of the Siberian coast line in the Chuckchea Sea. The Oregon Game Commission has notified the Russian agency that the birds had migrated to Oregon.

Barrow Earns Win

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—Kirk Barrow, Spokane's young heavy-weight, crawled off the canvas after a first-round knockdown and went on to decision Monroe Ratliff of San Diego in a 10-round bout. The fight, held at Kezar Pavilion, was Barrow's second win in a row.

Burgess, hoisting a 32-plus point average per game, sank 35 points in the contest. His last basket gave him 2,007 points for his college career. Louis Stout led the visitors with 20 points.

Goldberg To Visit Areas

WASHINGTON (AP)—Secretary of Labor Arthur J. Goldberg is reported planning an on-the-spot inspection this weekend of some of the nation's worst unemployment centers in the East and Midwest.

Plans for the trip are expected to be announced soon by the White House. The tour would have the twofold aim of pinpointing the extent of unemployment in the big cities, and also gathering data to present to Congress.

Goldberg will be the first witness when the House Ways and Means Committee opens hearings Feb. 15 on the administration's program to extend nearly \$1 billion extra aid to the nation's 3.4 million unemployed.
