OSLO (AP) — Prime Minister Einar Gerhardsen's office said today that a Western summit meeting in Oslo for the May 7-10 meeting of the North Atlantic Alliance is out of the question. Foreign Ministry spokesmen said Oslo lacks the hotel rooms to accommodate the 13 greatly enlarged delegations and the huge press corps that a NATO summit would bring.

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
