PENDELTON (AP)—An organization was created Tuesday night to promote industrial development in and around the Boardman Bombing Range, which Gov. Mark Hatfield wants to lease to the Boeing Airplane Co. for creation of space age industrial plants.

The organization, calling itself the Space Age Industrial Park Development Association, said it sent a telegram urging the Oregon Legislature, to acquire complete title to the land and to speedily reach agreement with Boeing over the lease.

In addition, William Belt Hermiston, president of the association, said there will be efforts to entice other industrial firms to the area.
