Hornets, Honkers In Title Test

KU Coach Reports

A-1 Tourney Officials See Tough Meet

"We expect another fine tournament—and some real tough competition," commented Art Litchman, University of Oregon athletic director, in a brief message to the Pelican Booster Club Wednesday night.

Litchman, who renewed many acquaintanceships with Klamath Falls perennial tourney goers, also had high praise for local athletes and the manner in which the KF sports program is conducted.

Another out-of-town guest, Ralph Dyson, former Sutherland coach,

now a member of the State Department of Education, added his congratulations, commenting especially on the development of the physical education program in operation on the primary school level.

Pelican basketball coach Dean White, who had an opportunity to see Portland area teams in action Tuesday, emphasized Litchman's remark concerning competition to be expected at the tournament.

Said White, after mentioning that Pel guard Freddie Biehn was

at least temporarily sidelined with an injured left hand, "I saw the Grant-Wilson game, and while this year's Generals are not as good as the '58 squad—they are plenty tough—a tall squad with lots of depth. They can run and shoot."

Wilson, on the other hand, is tough on the boards also, but is a more deliberate team choosing to work the ball for the good shot.

Of the St. Helens' Lions, he said, "They are a typical SH team—they can score quick and well, but they do lack of

height." He added that in talking with Lion coach Gene Strehlou he learned that the St. Helens' early season faltering had been blamed on a faulty defense but that the situation had been corrected.

When asked if Wally Palmberg and Bruce Brickner, the recuperating Pelicans, would be ready for action this weekend against Central Point, there Friday, and Ashland, here Saturday night, he replied that every member of the squad, with the possible exception of Biehn, would play.



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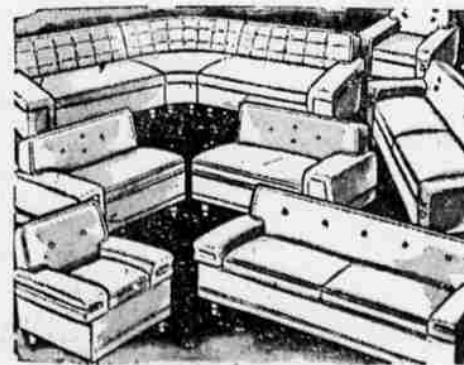
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
