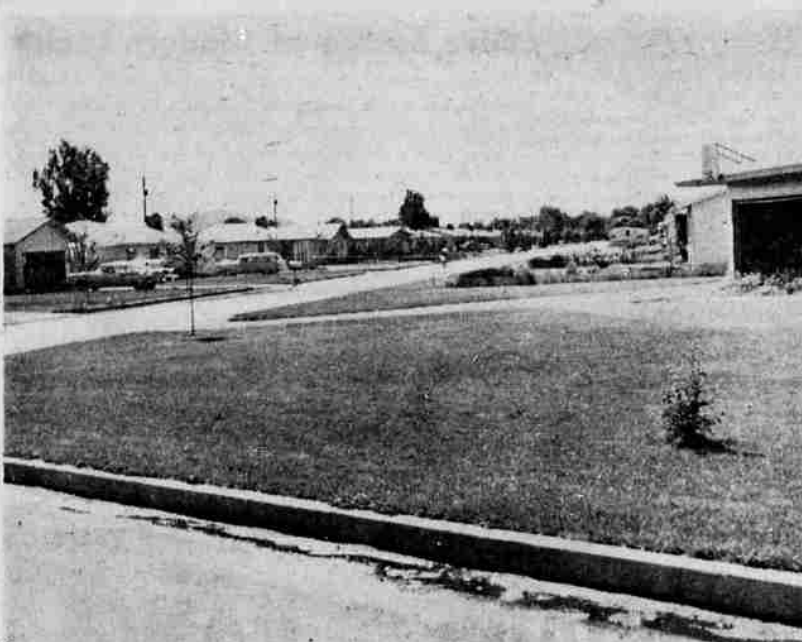
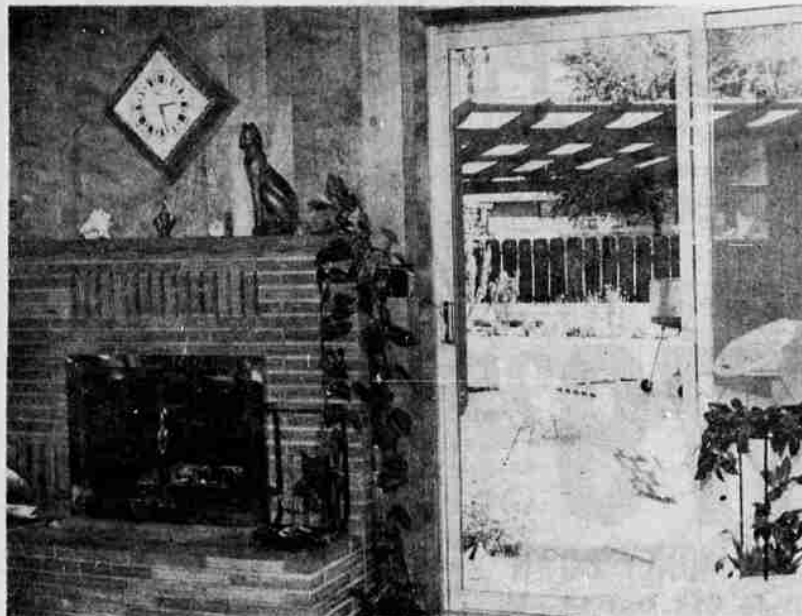




ONE OF THE MANY new areas of development in Klamath Falls shows neat modern homes, all with spacious yards, attractive to families with small children.

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Danger Signals Listed In Faulty Home Wiring

Do the lights in your home go dim momentarily when a major appliance turns on?

Do you have frequent trouble with blown fuses or circuit breakers tripping off?

Does your TV picture shrink when too many lights or appliances are on at the same time?

If any of these happen regularly in your home chances are your wiring is inadequate. These are three danger signals.

There now are more than 150 electric appliances on the market and many homeowners have accumulated many of them without realizing how much of a drain they are putting on the wiring of, say, a 30-year-old home.

To understand how your wiring works, compare the flow of electricity into your home with the flow of water through pipes.

Outside your home there is a main pipe with plenty of power in it. The problem is to get enough of it into the house when and where it is needed. Just as small pipes restrict the flow of water, small wires restrict the flow of electricity.

Electrical experts offer four of what they consider essential requirements for persons planning to buy or modernize a home:

1. A three-wire, 100-ampere service entrance. A dependable

electrical contractor will help you determine your needs, but be sure to plan for the future.

2. Three kinds of branch circuits: several general purpose circuits for lights all over the house; several small appliance circuits for outlets in the kitchen, laundry and dining area; and one separate circuit for each major appliance such as washer, air conditioner, freezer and the like.

3. Adequate outlets including one ceiling fixture lighting outlet in each room; convenience outlets in living areas at least every six feet along the floor line; one outlet for each four feet of work counter in the kitchen plus one for the refrigerator; a weatherproof outlet for outdoor use, and a special outlet for each major appliance.

4. Adequate switches, including one at the latch side of every doorway or room entrance; at the top and bottom of every stairway; at bedside for control of bedroom ceiling lights; inside switches for outdoor lights as well as switches in the garage or terrace.

SNOW TRAP
