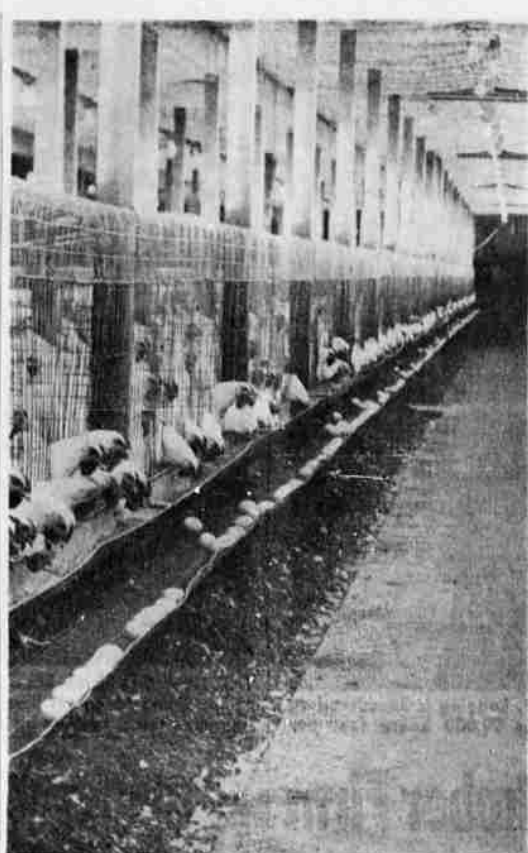

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Poultry Farming Has Narrow Profit

Poultry farming is no exception to the rule in other agricultural programs of larger operations on fewer farms. With narrow margins of profits for poultrymen in this cost-squeeze era, top management practices and poultry numbers are the principal answers to success.

While the poultry business in Klamath County is not numbered in the top agricultural income bracket perhaps, those producers who are equipped to handle large numbers of layers and who can take advantage of high tonnage being buying are making comfortable incomes.

Eggs produced here are all consumed locally. These eggs, handled to reach the consumer within a short time from the laying houses, essentially are of better quality than eggs shipped across country from the South, East or Midwest, in refrigerated trucks.

To achieve this goal of top quality eggs, local producers have perfected improvements in housing, egg handling and merchandising, to progress with the trend in the larger egg producing communities elsewhere in the West. Part of the responsibility of getting fresh eggs of high quality over the counter to the buyer also lies with the retailer who must provide proper storage and get eggs to the consumer without delay.
