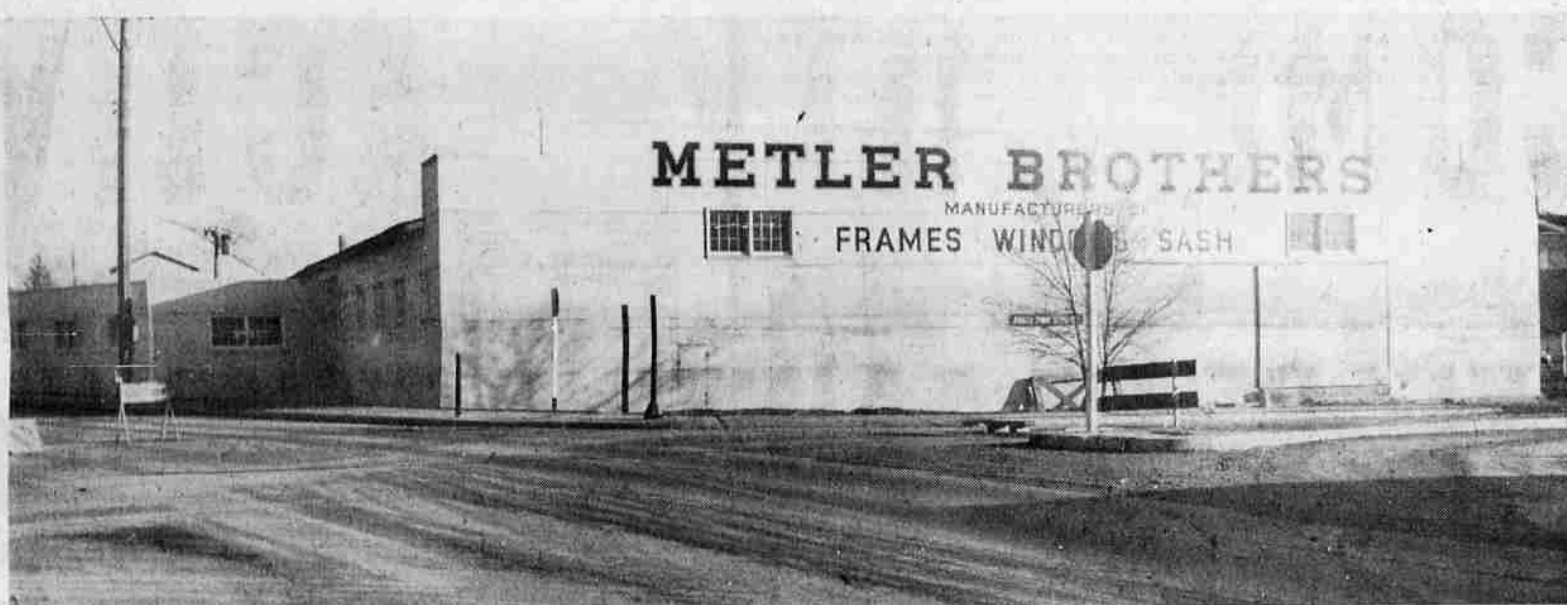

Modern construction techniques call for precision cut millwork to aid in the nation's building program, and Metler Bros. has answered that call by adding the latest, most modern equipment to turn out windows and door frames gauged to the 32nd of an inch.

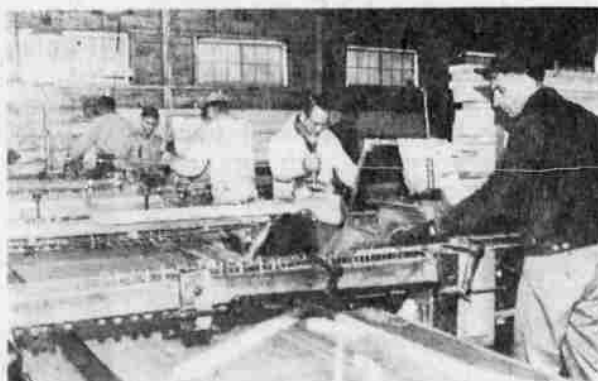
- ★ 15,000 Windows Produced Monthly

Metler Bros. has grown from a small plant, employing 15 men to one of Klamath's leading manufacturing plants with more than 60 employees. Between 5 and 6 million board feet of locally produced lumber are processed each year. The windows and door frames produced by Metler Bros. are ready for the carpenter to assemble. The frames are cut, grooved, and given termite and water repellent treatment before they leave the plant.
