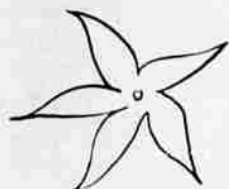

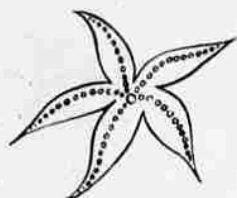

Let's Draw a Starfish

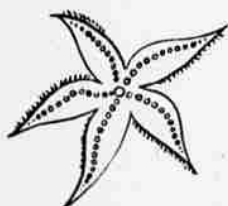

Indoor Coral Garden

A coral garden makes an attractive centerpiece for the table. You can make one in a fascinating way.

Take a clean lump of soft coal. Place it in a shallow glass dish. Pour over the coal a solution of one tablespoon each of water, salt, and bluing.

After a few days, white "reefs" or crystals will form on the coal. More interest and color may be added by sprinkling the "garden" with a few drops of colored ink.

Every other day, pour into the dish one teaspoon of water mixed with one teaspoon of salt. Be careful not to pour the solution directly on the growing crystals, and do not shake the dish, as this may jar the crystals off the coal.
