## Patio vs. Terrace

when you are away from home. So use materials that can't be harmed. I like a combination of plastic and sailcloth. Cover the cushions and mattresses with the waterproof plastic and then recover with slips of the sailcloth. It might seem that the other way round would be best, but plastic is not pleasant to sit on when it has been left in the sun. It sticks and it can be uncomfortably hot. The sailcloth will dry quickly if the "innards" are protected by the weatherproof material, and it is remarkable how much sun it can stand before it fades.

Finally, don't use elaborate planting around the patio. Save that for places where the traffic is not so heavy. Herbs make excellent plantings for the patio because they are fragrant, usually hardy, and can stand abuse. You can always use your houseplants to provide an exotic note if you can find a protected corner.

A fountain, one of the kind that uses the same water over and over, is a perfect companion for

a drowsy summer day and will keep the air in the patio cool and moist.

Keep your patio simple, practical and about twice the size as your indoor living space, and you will enjoy it all summer long.
