Youth Given Jail Term On Forgery

Richard W. Wayburn, a 21-year-old Klamath Falls youth, was sentenced to five years in the Oregon Correctional Institution in Salem Monday morning by Judge David R. Vandenberg.

Wayburn, 419 North Tenth Street, last week pleaded guilty to a charge of knowingly uttering and publishing a forged bank check. He had previously pleaded not guilty.

The young man was arrested Feb. 20 after he allegedly cashed some payroll checks which had been stolen from Western Pipeline Co. Police said he cashed checks in Klamath Falls and Eugene.

The specific check he was convicted on was for \$257.41; he allegedly cashed the worthless check at Melatore's Motel, 100 Main Street on Feb. 9.

Wayburn was placed on probation last year for an auto theft.

In other circuit court action Monday, Judge Vandenberg denied

a motion to quash the indictment against Duane F. Wilson, 38, 1109 28 Pine Street, charged with obtaining money and property by false pretenses. He entered a plea of not guilty to passing a worthless \$20 check to Miller's Department

Store, 512 Main Street last Nov. 28. Defense attorney Glenn D. Ramirez had moved to quash the indictment on the grounds that the same charge had been previously dismissed by the district attorney.

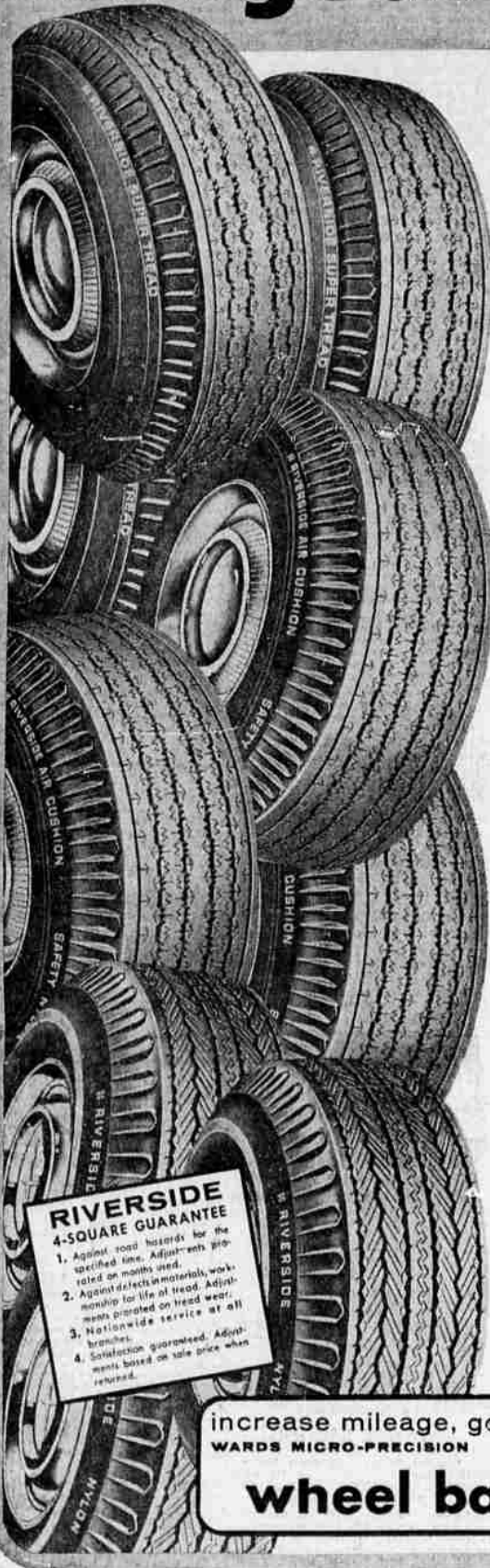
