

Budget Vote Set May 1

Voters of Klamath County School District will go to the polls May 1 to decide whether the district should exceed the "six per cent limitation," concerning local property tax receipts, and to elect a school board member from the southern zone comprising the Merrill and Malin areas.

Petition forms required for filing for the board vacancy may be obtained at the county school office in Veterans Memorial Building at the county courthouse complex.

The forms must be signed by at least 10 registered voters in the district and they must be returned to the office by April 1 in order for the candidate's name to appear on the ballot.

Only registered voters of the district may vote. March 31 is the deadline for registration with the county clerk.

The district this year is asking the voters to okay a total of \$933,738 outside the limitation law. The law prohibits levy of more than six per cent of the highest "tax base" of the preceding three years. A tax base is the amount within the six per cent limitation.

Nikita Talks Of Communist World

MOSCOW (AP)—Premier Khrushchev told the Soviet people today that they can rest content only when the whole world goes Communist.

"We are happy when we build communism (there) but that is not enough," he said. "We shall be happy when the people of all the countries stand under the banner of Marxism-Leninism and the Communist banner will fly over the whole planet."

Khrushchev spoke on a nationwide radio hookup from Alma Ata, capital of the virgin land republic of Kazakhstan. This was the second speech of his current tour of agricultural areas to be broadcast live.

His declaration about the ultimate victory of communism got a storm of applause from the leading farmers and party functionaries gathered to hear him.

"Opponents of communism will say that Khrushchev expresses pretentious claims for the rule of communism," the premier said. "It is not a claim but a deep conviction based on a profound theory of the development of human society. It does not depend on me or any one person."

Much of his speech was keyed to the need for industrial and agricultural advances in the Soviet Union so it can overtake the United States. He predicted this would happen soon.

Referring to international affairs, Khrushchev repeated his standard offer to accept "any controls" for disarmament if the West will accept his proposals for general and complete disarmament.

The West dismisses this offer from Khrushchev as meaningless because it is never backed up by any agreement to specific control measures.

"I am certain that this regressive action does not truly present the will of Oregon's citizens, particularly in view of the well-known and obvious waste problems involving the pollution of our streams, lakes, beaches and suburban areas."

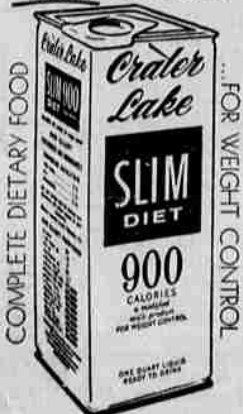
