GEORGE PRICE, city parks and recreation director, was appointed this week by the Klamath County Board of Directors to head up a division for the 1962 campaign beginning next fall.

Thus, an impending classroom shortage has been headed off temporarily, board members believe. They do not expect to have to use room in Ponderosa School in the city elementary school district, as previously discussed and approved by both boards, an official stated.

Finally, they elected Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Bice of Yreka as physical education and English instructors, respectively. The board took no action following opening of four bids for fuel for next school year. Nor did members act on a proposal to build a joint elementary - high school warehouse, bus garage and administration center near Ponderosa School, under discussion for a considerable length of time.

The 18-year-old soldier is a 1959 graduate of Mt. Rogers High School in Whitetop, Va. Faircloth, a fire direction control operator in the artillery's headquarters battery in Geinhausen, entered the Army last May, completed basic training at Fort Ord, Calif., and arrived overseas last October.
