

Mother Hospitalized After Crash

A young mother of three from Gresham was rushed to Klamath Valley Hospital early Wednesday morning with undetermined injuries after a one-car crash on Highway 97 in the Sand Creek area.

Injured was Mrs. Betty Kim, 25, who was driving north about one mile north of Fuego Junction when the accident occurred. State police said Mrs. Kim had possible fractures of the collarbone, ribs and back.

Police speculated that Mrs. Kim might have fallen asleep at the wheel. The car apparently went off the highway on the left side, swerved back onto the roadway, flipped over on its top and rolled end over end, coming to rest overturned in the roadside ditch.

Mrs. Kim's husband, George, 37, and three small children were sleeping in the car and were uninjured. Police said the family had left Sacramento Tuesday night. City police investigated one collision Tuesday afternoon. A car owned by Douglas W. Clement, 20, of 1833 Hope Street, rolled backwards in the Market Basket parking lot at Ninth and Pine streets and ran into a parked car owned by Duane E. Reeder, 25, 2834 Patterson Street. Clement said his brakes failed. No citation was issued, police said, because the accident happened on private property.

Labor Dispute Holds Projects

The commission said completion of some other projects is doubtful, depending on when the fall rains begin.

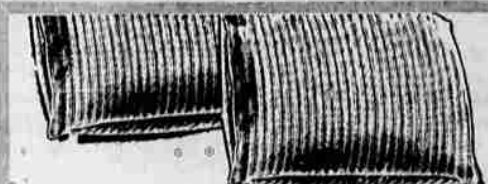
